DOOR COUNTY USBC ASSOCIATION BYLAWS

Article I

Name

The name of the organization is the Door County USBC Association, chartered by the *United States Bowling Congress (USBC)*.

The Door County USBC Association is an adult merged association in a non-merged State (WI).

Door County youth bowlers are not merged with the Door County USBC, but are merged in the *Green Bay Youth Bowling Association*. Youth bylaws will be added and adopted should the Door County youth merge with the Door County USBC.

Article II

Nonprofit Corporation and Charter

Section A. Nonprofit Corporation

The Association is organized as a nonprofit corporation and operates consistent with the requirements of an organization classified as tax exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (IRC).

Section B. Charter

The Association shall be chartered by USBC and subject to its authority. To maintain its charter, the association must:

1. Provide services for men and women.
2. Adopt bylaws approved by USBC.
3. Not enact any bylaws or rules inconsistent with *USBC Bylaws*.
4. Adhere to stated requirements as set forth in the *USBC Bylaws* and *USBC Association Policy Manual*.

Section C. Association Dissolution

Upon dissolution of this organization all of its assets remaining after payment of its lawful obligations shall be distributed in accordance with the requirements of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and regulations promulgated thereunder.

Article III Purpose

The purposes of the association as stated in the Articles of Incorporation, include, but are not limited to:

1. Providing equal opportunity for all in the sport of bowling without regard to race, religion, age, gender, disability, or national origin.
2. Promoting the game of American Tenpins.
3. Conducting and supporting bowling competition.
4. Engaging in any other activities permitted by an organization classified as tax exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the IRC.

Article IV Membership and Dues

Membership is in effect from August 1 through July 31 and is composed of:

1. **Adults** who have paid the appropriate USBC, state and local association dues.

Each individual shall pay annual USBC membership dues, local dues (adult) or local processing fee and State Association dues, except as provided in Rule 100e, Traveling League and 100l, Mail-o-Graphic League.

The adult members, and all officers and directors, by two-thirds vote, determine and adopt local dues, if any.

The annual adult standard membership dues are as follows:

Senior Men/Women (age 65 as of August 1)

State	\$ 0.00 (Cannot exceed \$1)*
USBC adult standard membership	<u>\$10.00</u>
Total	\$12.00

*\$1 WI State dues for women choosing to be State members is paid by the Door County USBC Association.

The Board may waive all or part of local adult dues for:

1. Members of other USBC associations having a reciprocal agreement with the association.
2. Other groups, such as seniors, etc., as determined the Board.

The association cannot charge additional non-dues assessments.

Article V

Board of Directors - Management

Section A. Board Composition, Authority and Duties

The management and governance of the association is vested in the Board of Directors that includes the Officer and Director positions. The members determine the number of positions on the Board of Directors and their term. The total number of board members is 10, with 8 total number of directors. Of the 8 directors, 1 shall be a youth director.

Should the Door County youth merge with the Door County USBC, at least 20% of the total number of Board members will be elected by the Youth Representatives and officers and directors who hold youth membership. The number of Board members elected by the Youth Representatives and officers and directors who hold youth membership will be 2 (one boy and one girl).

The Board shall not engage in any acts constituting a conflict of interest. The Board's duties include but are not limited to:

1. Enforcing the bylaws.
2. Complying with the *USBC Association Policy Manual*.

3. Conducting championship level competition for its membership constituency (men, women) and complying with state and local laws in their area.
4. Implementing USBC programs as requested.
5. Selecting/appointing the Association Manager.
6. Approving use of membership records.
7. Re-rating the league average of an association member when there is evidence the bowler's average does not represent the bowler's true ability.
8. Conducting suspension and reinstatement hearings if requested by USBC Headquarters.

Section B. Eligibility

A candidate for the Board (elected or appointed) must be:

1. A USBC member in good standing of the association at the time of election and throughout their term.
2. Elected or appointed without regard to race, color, religion, gender, disability, national origin, or age, other than the minimum age of 14, unless state laws mandate a specific age, and be reasonably representative of the membership.
 - a. Any member of the Board authorized to sign contracts or acting as a signatory on association accounts must be a minimum age of 18.
 - b. A maximum of three bowling center proprietors may serve on the Board at one time. A proprietor is an individual who is the owner, partner, or corporate officer of a bowling center or group of bowling centers. Excluded from the definition of proprietor is an individual who owns 25% or less of the equity shares, or who is inactive in the management of the bowling center and remains so during a term as an officer or director.

Additional eligibility requirements, if any, are to be approved by the members.

Section C. Election of Officers

Directors are elected by majority, unless plurality vote is adopted, by the members. Directors whose positions are subject to election by the adult members are elected by majority vote of adult members, and all officers and directors, present and voting from:

1. A slate.
2. Nominations from the floor.

Qualifications must be submitted in a format specified by the Board.

Voting will be by ballot if there is more than one nominee for each position.

Section D. Term

The term for directors is 3 years. The members determine the number of years in a term and the number of terms allowed. For two- and three-year terms the members establish a stagger system.

Year 1: President, 3 Directors

Year 2: Vice President, 3 Directors

Year 3: President, 2 Directors

Section E. Resignation, Removal, and Vacancies

1. **Resignation.** A Board member may resign from the Board of Directors by providing written notice of resignation to the president or, in the case of the president, to the Board.
2. **Removal for Ineligibility.** A Board member who is no longer eligible to serve on the Board may be removed by a two-thirds vote of the Board when a quorum is present.
3. **Removal for Cause.** When a Board member is accused, in writing, of failure to properly perform the duties of their office or otherwise engaging in improper or unfair activities or conduct, the Board may conduct a meeting following the Removal Procedures in the Suspension and Reinstatement Chapter. An appeal may be filed with USBC Headquarters within 15 days of the removal. Two-thirds written consent of the full Board is required to seek re-election and/or re-appointment to the Board.
4. **Vacancies.** Vacancies in positions on the Board are filled for the un-expired portion of each term as follows:
 - a. If elected by the members, director vacancies are filled by the president, subject to approval by the Board.
 - b. The Board fills vacancies in officer positions.

Article VI Officers

Section A. President and Vice President

The officers of this association shall include a president and vice president.

Section B. Election

The members determine the election process.

1. Officers are elected by a majority vote of the adult members, officers and directors, present and voting from:
 - a. A slate.
 - b. Nominations from the floor.

Qualifications must be submitted in a format specified by the Board.

Voting will be by ballot if there is more than one nominee for each position.

Section C. Term

The term for elected officers is 2 years. By USBC mandate, terms may exceed three years. There is no limit to the number of terms allowed.

Section D. Authority and Duties

1. President

- a. Presides at all meetings.
- b. Acts as spokesperson for the association.
- c. Appoints committees with Board approval.

2. Vice President

- a. Presides at all meetings when the president is absent.
- b. Performs other duties as prescribed by the Board or requested by the president.

3. Association Manager

- a. Selected/appointed by and accountable to the Board
- b. Acts as the ex officio non-voting secretary/treasurer of the Board or such other officer designation as required by law and determined by the Board.
- c. Responsible for other duties as prescribed by the Board and in the *USBC Association Policy Manual*.

Article VII Meetings

Section A. Annual Meeting

An Annual Meeting of association members shall be held at a time and place approved by the Board of Directors.

1. Attendance

Attendance is open to all members.

Voice and Vote

Voting officers, directors, and adult members. Members not meeting the above criteria may attend with voice only. Absentee and proxy voting are not permitted.

2. Responsibilities

- a. All adult members, officers and directors shall elect delegates and alternates for the USBC Annual Meeting.
- b. Adult members and all officers and directors shall:
 1. Adopt bylaws.
 2. Adopt local adult dues, up to the established maximum
 3. Elect up to 80% of the total number of Board members.
 4. Elect delegates and alternates representing adult membership for the state annual meetings.

5. Meeting Notice

Written notice of the meeting shall be forwarded to the league secretaries at least 15 days prior to the annual meeting.

6. Special Meetings

Special membership meetings may be called by the president or upon written request of at least three (3) Board members or at least twenty-five (25) members of the Association.

7. Quorum

- a. 6 Members constitute a quorum. The members determine the number.

8. Action

A majority vote of those members present and voting, at properly noticed meeting, when a quorum has been established, is required to take action, unless otherwise provided by law or these bylaws. Election of officers requires a majority vote. Election of directors requires a majority vote, unless plurality vote has been adopted in accordance with the bylaws. Election of delegates and alternates requires a plurality vote. Absentee and proxy voting are not permitted.

Section B. Board Meeting

The Board shall meet, at a minimum, as often as required by state law. Special meetings may be held upon request of any Board member if a majority of the Board approves.

1. **Notice.** Written notice for all regular and special meetings shall be forwarded to the Board, which should be at least 15 days prior to the meeting.
2. **Quorum.** 6 Board members constitute a quorum. The members determine the number.
3. **Action.** A majority vote of those officers and directors present and voting, at a properly noticed meeting, when a quorum has been established, is required to take action, unless otherwise provided by law or these bylaws. Absentee and proxy voting are not permitted.
4. **Action(s) Without a Meeting.** Actions that are deemed necessary to conduct business/operations of the Association may be taken outside of a Board meeting by use of mail, e-mail or teleconferencing. This type of action must be permissible by State law and approved by the membership/Youth Representatives and the Board.
The Association does allow the Board to vote via mail, e-mail, or teleconference.

Section C. Parliamentary Procedure

The most recent of *Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised*, governs all meetings.

Article VIII Committees

Section A. Standing Committees

The Association shall have the following Standing Committee: Finance.

1. **Finance Committee.** The committee is responsible for reviewing and monitoring Association financial matters.

Section B. Other Committees

The President may establish other committees, with Board approval.

Article IX

Delegates, Youth Delegates and Alternates

Section A. USBC Annual Meeting

Delegates and alternates are elected by plurality vote of those adult members and officers and directors, present and voting. (Note: A delegate must be 18 years or older and holds a USBC membership.)

Section B. State Annual Meeting

1. Delegates and alternates representing adults are elected by plurality vote of those adult members present and voting.

Section C. Eligibility

1. **USBC Annual Meeting.** Delegates and Alternates must be:
 - a. Elected by the Board, adult members and Youth Representatives.
 - b. At least 18 years of age.
 - c. A USBC member in good standing of the Association at the time of election and throughout their term.
2. **State Annual Meetings.** Delegates and Alternates must be:
 - a. Elected by adult members.
 - b. At least 18 years of age.
 - c. A USBC member in good standing of the Association at the time of election and throughout their term.

If a member is elected to represent more than one association to attend the same meeting, the first election shall stand and any succeeding election shall be declared null and void.

A local association is not eligible to send delegates if it is declared delinquent or USBC has revoked its charter. (Note: An association that has not processed dues for the current season shall be considered delinquent.)

Section D. Election

Delegates and alternates serve for one year, beginning August 1, and are elected by:

1. A slate.

2. Nominations from the floor (qualifications must be submitted in a format specified by the Board).
3. Plurality vote. The election shall be by ballot, except that a voice vote may be taken when the number of candidates does not exceed the number of positions to be filled.
4. Alternates shall serve in order of their election.

The election is to be held in compliance with the USBC or State Annual Meeting requirements.

Section E. Vacancies

Vacancies are filled for the un-expired portion of each term as follows:

1. If elected by adult members, vacancies are filled by the alternates in the order in which they were elected. If a vacancy still exists, the President fills the vacant position by appointment.

The appointee must also meet the same eligibility requirements as elected positions.

Article X Amendments

Section A. Procedure

Any member of the Association may submit proposed amendments to these bylaws. The local association bylaws may be amended at any membership meeting by a two-thirds vote of the members present and voting. The amendment must be:

1. Submitted in writing to the Association Manager or President.
2. Submitted at least 30 days prior to the membership meeting when the Association is considering the proposal.

Section B. Change in Adult Dues

Forward a notice to each league secretary and the Board at least 15 days prior to the meeting at which the proposed change is considered. The notice must:

1. Be in writing.
2. Specify the amount of the change.
3. Specify the reason for the change.

Notification of any adopted change in adult dues, and the reason for the change, will be forwarded, in writing, to each league secretary.

Section C. Effective Date

All amendments are effective August 1, following adoption, unless otherwise specified when adopted.

**Article XI
Fiscal Year**

The fiscal year of the Association is August 1 through July 31.

**Article XII
Indemnification**

Directors, officers, and other authorized volunteers, employees or agents shall be indemnified against claims for personal individual liability arising in connection with their positions or service on behalf of the Association to the full extent permitted by law.

DOOR COUNTY USBC ANNUAL DELEGATES MEETING

August 11, 2014 Apple Valley Lanes

President Bernie Haen called the meeting to order at 7:32 p.m.

Roll call showed Jim Regner, Mike Daubner, Michelle Pfannenstiel, Todd Jacobs, Jamie Kerscher and Bob Nelson present.

Rose Polcen and Jen Pollock were absent.

League Delegates present were: Kathy Franke of the Apple Dumplings, Jeff Isaksen of Apple Valley Majors, Todd Jacobs of the Wednesday Washouts & the Early Sunday Mixed, Joan Franda of the Women's Masters, Momzi Jutila of the Apple Valley Classic, Joy Bordeaux of the Women's Apple Corp., Kerri Rentmeester of the Northerners and Mike Daubner of the Sister Bay Tavern League.

The following league was not represented: Odd Couples

Secretary's report of August 7, 2013 was presented in written form and summarized. No changes or additions were suggested. Motion to accept as written by Joy Bordeaux, seconded by Mike Daubner, passed.

Financial Report, including HOF and Tournament financial statements, and Membership information were presented in written form. The financial report showed all deposits and expenses for sanctions, Hall of Fame Banquet and the County Tournament. Detailed financial reports from the Hall of Fame and the County Tournament were also distributed. Due to running 50/50 raffles 2 years ago to help cover expenses, the HOF banquet is \$31 over. The Tournament account is \$167 over and will be added to the prize fund next year. The membership chart showed an increase in sanctions of 12, our 1st increase in 9 years. Since the 2003-04 season, we have lost 165 members. At \$6 per person, this adds up to a loss of almost \$990/year. Leagues continue to pay for their BLS updates and the extra raffles from 2 years ago have offset the HOF banquet costs through this past year. As a result, the year-end statement shows the Association to be at about even.

Committee Reports

Finance (Bernie*, Jim, Kathy): All has been reviewed and is in order. Monthly bank statements are forwarded to the President on a monthly basis and everything balances out to the penny. Kathy has been very thorough in maintaining accurate records and keeping the Association funds in check.

Youth (Michelle): This year there were 30 sanctioned junior bowlers. Apple Valley held 2 Adult/Youth tournaments. Four (4) teams participated in the Youth State Tournament, 4 bowlers qualified for the 500-600 Tournament, 10 bowlers bowled in the High Average Tournament in Green Bay, and 4 teams went to the City Tournament.

Hall of Fame (Kathy*, Bernie, Michelle, Jim, Rose, Jamie): We held our Annual Hall of Fame banquet on 10/19/13 with 62 people in attendance. Tracy May was inducted into the Hall of Fame for Superior Performance and Mandy Plaszkiewicz and Nick Cater were honored as our Junior Bowlers of the Year. Reggie Buadhuin & Dale Englebert were recognized for their 1st ever 800 series. Gary Guidinger, Travis Rosinsky & Mike Snell were awarded one-time 300 awards for their 1st ever perfect games. Certificates were also awarded to our Youth coaches, Kathy Franklin, Tim Forbes, Bill Hall and Tim

Jutila. County Tournament winners and Association High Game, High Series, High Average and Most Improved Average winners were also honored. Special guests Don Hildebrand and his wife, Krista, from the Men's State Association were in attendance, as well as former State President Don Boulanger and wife Carole.

Two years ago we ran 50/50 raffles in all our leagues to raise money to defer banquet costs due to our declining membership. We were able to cover all costs for 2 years without monetary support from the Association. It will have to be decided how to approach fund raising for future banquets.

Unfortunately, with the changes in the Association this year and no one willing to replace Kathy as Chairperson and Jim & Bernie as Committee members, the HOF Banquet for 2014 has been cancelled.

Tournament (Jim*, Todd, Bob, Mike, Kathy): We had a very successful tournament this year and the prize fund was boosted by selling advertising and also obtaining extra money from 2 beer distributors. The team event was held at Sister Bay Bowl and the minor events at Apple Valley Lanes and participation was good at both houses. We have 2 divisions and entries are open to all Door County sanctioned bowlers. Jim thanks all the participants and advertisers. We had over \$3700 in prize money this year—great job!! This was Jim's last year chairing the Tournament Committee. Bob Nelson and Todd Jacobe will take over as Tournament Joint Chairs. Jim will help them get started.

Nominating (Rose*, Mike, Jim): The following positions were up for re-election: President Bernie Haen (1 year), Vice President Jim Regner and Director Mike Daubner. Bernie has 1 year left on his term and is unable to complete it. Vice President Jim Regner is not seeking re-election.

A slate of 2 bowlers was presented by Jim Regner: Kerri Rentmeester and DeDe Landstrom. Mike Daubner will accept re-election. Todd Jacobe was nominated by Michelle Pfannenstiel and accepted the position of Vice President for 2 years. Motion to accept these 3 as new Directors for the next 3 years and VP for the next 2 years was made and passed.

The position of President was not filled. It is up to the Board to find a replacement for Bernie. This position must be filled as we are a Corporation and law dictates we have a fully operating Board with a President.

A big THANK YOU goes out to Bernie and Jim for all their hard work these past years in moving our Association forward.

Delegates Reports

- A. Bernie attended the Annual State Meeting in January. The Lane Inspection program was reviewed. USBC had wanted to initiate a test program where professional lane inspectors would do the lanes at houses in WI, WY & CT. Due to the amount of negative feedback from proprietors, the program has been deferred.

This year USBC has initiated Performance Standards for all Associations. This is being done in an effort to standardize the requirements and deadlines across the board for all Associations. Things that will be monitored will be timely submissions of sanctions, hosting a membership (County) tournament, conducting an Annual Meeting and Association Manager duties of submitting Board Member information, WinLabs program updates and taxes, etc. Results will not be released nationally; they will be sent only to each Association so that they know how they are doing.

B. No one attended the Women's State Annual Meeting in March.

New Business

- A. Awards program: There are enough of most awards (bag tags & magnets) to offer them this year. A survey was distributed to all league secretaries for their teams to fill out to help determine what type of awards bowlers would like. Kathy also distributed information on certificates created by USBC that can be printed off of bowl.com.
- B. BLS 2014 Update: Now that awards are no longer offered by USBC, there was discussion as to whether the BLS programs needed to be updated. An update is \$29. Michelle would like to update every 3-4 years, but this would force leagues to then buy new programs at \$129. It was agreed to update this year and see what happens next year.
- C. Local dues increase: no discussion
- D. More Board members/more help for HOF & Tournament: no discussion
- E. Association Manager position: no discussion—as in previous meetings the position and current level of performance has been marginalized, so Kathy will resign as of October 1, 2014. It is her hope that the new Association Manager is given more respect.
- F. Suggestions/Feedback from Delegates: none

Motion to adjourn by Michelle Pfannenstiel, seconded by Bob Nelson, passed. Meeting adjourned at 8:41 p.m.

Saying goodbye to the Wednesday Night Washout League

For a variety of reasons, I've thrown the final ball of the season in the Wednesday Night Washout League many times.

My teams usually don't throw a lot of strikes, and we're known to be a bit "chatty." Then, there's the trips to the bar, slowing us down.

I've been the anchor-man on most of my teams, but for the past few seasons I've bowled in the fourth position. When it came down to the end last week, I swapped positions with our anchor, Mike Schumacher, in the 10th frame so I could finish out the year one final time.

After 27 seasons, this was my last in the Washout.

I started out bowling for the Door County Advocate team back in 1986-

87. My teammates were Tom Anschutz, Steve Squier, Bob Hunsader and Bud Stroh. The next season, I began bowling in the Crab Apple League on Thursday nights on a team with Tom Johnson, Paul Shefchik, Jeff Schartner and Darren Hesler. When my average improved, I switched from Thursdays to Tuesdays in the Apple Valley Majors, which was a scratch league until a couple of years ago. My Nightengale team at the time included Tim Jutila, Bill Jarman, Ted Peterson and Bruce Kruswick.

My time in the Majors lasted a few seasons. But when it came time to cut back after Caroline was born, I stuck with the Washout.

I was 27 years old when I first bowled in the Washout, half my life ago. We younger guys joked about how we'd one day be the "old guys" in the league, like Bill Mieler and Don Ohlrogge and the rest of the team that came back from 100 pins down in the ninth frame to beat us one night by throwing 13 of 15 strikes in the tenth.

I almost made it. There aren't many left from when I started who will outlast me. Joe Heilman for sure. I'm thinking Bill Kroll, Randy Franda and Jeff Paschke were there from the beginning. Maybe Lenny DeFere. Maybe Jeff May. Mike Hoyt

probably hasn't bowled in the Washout in more than a decade, but May still shouts, "Hang Hoyt!" every once in a while after throwing a strike.

In between my first Washout team and my current team of Schumacher, Bill Hall, Sam Heimbecher and Chris and Steve Greninger, I've bowled with a lot of guys. Jim Anschutz, Mitch Eisen and Jim Parks the longest.

I had started the night needing 706 to reach my goal of averaging 220 for the season. Despite starting with a 267 for the second straight week, a subsequent rash of nine counts and two missed 10-pins left that objective hanging by a thread — eventually cut by a poorly thrown ball in the seventh frame of the third game that resulted in the 2-8.

With the lanes all to myself for the final time, I buried the first two for strikes. But I made too big a deal out of the last ball and came up high, leaving the 6-10. A ringing 10-pin would have been much more appropriate.

I was the last one out of the bar. Not that it was very late; everyone clears out on weeknights. I jammed everything in locker 77 into my ball bag, turned in my key and headed back to my new home in Green Bay.

Injury couldn't keep Hall of Fame inductee off lanes

As a person who would be lucky to stay upright trying to bowl with my opposite hand, I have boundless respect for Tracy Schultz May, the Door County USBC Hall of Fame inductee for 2013.

Due to an injury, May spent the 2008-09 and 2009-10 seasons bowling left-handed, averaging 137 and 142 in successive years.

Of course, her election to the hall in the superior performance category had much more to do with her right-handed exploits. May has averaged in the high 170s and 180s since the 1994-95 season, including bests of 186 in both 1996-97 and 1999-2000. She has thrown 37 series of 600 or better since she first joined the 600 Club in 1994, and has a high career game

of 276, rolled during the 1994-95 season.

She was part of the winning doubles event team in the Door County USBC Tournament in 2007, as well as doubles champion in the Door County Women's WIBC in 1997. Her most impressive accomplishment on the lanes came in 2000, when she was crowned State Champion in the Women's Tournament held that year in Green Bay.

May also spent many seasons active in the local WIBC Association. She was a board member from 1993-98,

served on the Budget and Finance and the Policy and Procedure committees from 1993-95, and handled auditing and Sergeant-at-Arms duties from 1996-98.

Unfortunately, her abilities with off-handed bowling did not rub off on her husband, Jeff, last season. A balky rotator cuff in his right shoulder forced him to switch hands as Tracy had done four years earlier.

The results were not pretty.

Congratulations to Tracy Schultz May. Her induction will be held Saturday evening during the Door County USBC Hall of Fame Banquet at the Lodge at Leathem Smith in Sturgeon Bay. Junior Bowlers of the year Nick Cater and Mandy Plaskiewicz will also be honored, as well as Door

County tournament champions and the top scorers from last season.

Bowler rolls his first 300 in county tournament

After this past weekend, Bill Kröll might well be thinking about bowling more often at the Sister Bay Bowl.

Kröll ventured up north Sunday and rolled his first career 300 game in the team event of the Door County USBC Tournament. I haven't had a chance to talk to him about it yet, but I'm betting it's been quite a stretch since he last bowled there — if ever.

Kröll's perfect game was the third of this year's tournament, and the seventh of the season after a slower than normal start. In fact, five of the seven have come in the past three weeks or so.

I don't have the final results from the just completed team event or all-events, but I do have the standings of the minor events that were bowled at Apple Valley Lanes.

The only event Mike Snell didn't win last year was doubles. He took

care of that in this year's tournament by teaming up with Jason Daubner to total 1,489 in Division 1. Snell rolled a 706 series and Daubner shot 689.

Tim Moore and Tim Jutila placed second at 1,451, Cubby Hartl and Dale Englebert finished third with 1,436. Hartl's 744 series included his first perfect game, and Moore had 689.

In Division 2 doubles, Mark Hicks and Rich Benzshawel placed first with 1,455 combined pins. Benzshawel rolled a 696 series in winning the event for the second straight season. Runners-up were Jim Dupras and Bill Jarman at 1,436, edging out Len DeFere and Randy Fran- da with 1,433.

Jeff Plaszkievicz took the crown in Division 1 singles, shooting 735 scratch for an 821 total. Hartl bowled well again, finishing in second place on the strength of a 712 series and total of 774. The bronze went to Dale Englebert with 738 scratch and 748 total.

Jim Dupras won Division 2, totaling 838 including a 698 scratch series — a full 179 pins over average. He grabbed the trophy away from last season's winner, Heather Laughlin, on the final shift. Laughlin had 637 scratch and 793 total. Third place went to Rose Polcen with 760 (623 scratch).

A total of 38 doubles teams competed this year, including 20 in Division 1 and 18 in Division 2. There were 41 singles event entrants in Division 1 and 32 with lower averages.

The high series of the minor events portion of the tournament went to Mike Daubner, who

crashed a 752, including a 276 game in doubles. Plaszkievicz and Todd Cater each rolled 279 games. Cater totaled 717 in singles while Andy Alger (723), Nathan Bacher (717) and Geoff Hansen (702) all topped the 700 mark in doubles.

Besides Laughlin and Polcen, Kathy Franke (606 in singles) and Michelle Pfannenstiel (600 in doubles) recorded honor scores. High women's game in the minor events belonged to Gail Chadek with a 254 in doubles. Polcen rolled a 22,7 and Franke and Laughlin each had 224 games.

I should have final results from the team event — and the individual totals for all events — in time for next week's column.

Changes to final tournament standings

The 2014 Door County USBC Association Tournament is history. I've already recapped the singles and doubles competitions, which were held at Apple Valley Lanes, but I do have a couple of corrections to report.

Apparently, at least one other person besides me is seeing their average at Apple Valley soar this season. Jim Dupras let tournament officials know that his average is up 19 pins over last year, which means he had to have his handicap adjusted. So instead of winning division Division 2 singles, he was "kicked upstairs" to Division 1, where he finished second to Jeff Plaszkiwicz and dropped Cubby Hartl to third.

That leaves Heather Laughlin on top as repeat champion in Division 2, followed by Rose Polcen and Wade Gauger. Originally second in Division 2 doubles, Dupras and Bill Jarman dropped back to fifth. The winners remained Mark Hicks and Rich Benzshawel while Len DeFere and Randy Franda were bumped up to second, and Eddy Allen and Kathy Franke to third.

That brings us to the team event, held at the Sister Bay Bowl. Division 1 champions for the second year in a row were Alexanders from Sister Bay: Mike Snell (728), Brett Anschutz (650) and Jason Daubner (633), scoring a handicapped total of 2,145.

Teams from the northern part of the county rounded out the top three, with The Strikers second at 2,038 and the Viking in third at 1,964.

Division 2 champs were the Neighborhood Pub II team of James Livingston, Angie Livingston and Chris Gajda with 2,071. They may very well have had the highest combined handicap in the team event, but bowled well and won their division by more than 100 pins — a lesson for other high handicappers out there. Second place went to The Happy Hour (1,964) and third to The Mink (1,942).

The individual scoring highlight from the team event was Bill Kroll's first career perfect game. Kroll's 724 series was the second best of the event, following the 728 by Snell. Andy Alger rolled a 278 game on his way to a 660 series, and I had an unofficial 719 as a pacer the second Saturday so that one team wouldn't need to bowl unopposed.

If I had managed to get a full team together, I probably wouldn't have done nearly as well.

All-events is the total of individual bowler scores from singles, doubles and team. The Division 1 champion for

2014 was Hartl, with 2,232. That included a 744 in doubles with a 300 game, a 712 series in singles and 590 in the team event. Second place went to Division 1 singles champ Plaszkiwicz at 2,211. Snell finished in third (2,182), followed by Mike Daubner (2,148) and Geoff Hansen (2,135).

The Division 2 all-events title went to Bill Jarman with a total of 2,140. Runner-up was Laughlin at 2,107, who holds the Laughlin household honors for another season over her husband, Jim, who placed third at 2,081. John Rankin finished fourth (2,040) by a pin over John Haen.

As I mentioned briefly to lead off last week's column, Mike Snell has now won five events over the past two association tournaments, easily the best two-year run in Door County bowling history. Maybe we can convince him that mid-January to mid-February is an excellent time for a vacation. There were three perfect games recorded in the tournament, and a multitude of great scores.

Local bowlers roll well in senior tournament

A couple of weeks back, I asked my Wednesday night bowling teammates, Mike Schumacher and Bill Hall, how things had gone for them on their trip to the Wisconsin State USBC Seniors Tournament in Stevens Point. Their responses were underwhelming, leading me to believe that no one in their group had done anything newsworthy.

So then, I'm reading Jim Zima's bowling column Monday in the Green Bay Press-Gazette and find out that not only did they bowl well, but as this year's competition nears the halfway point, they're both near the top.

Hall currently leads the singles event in the 75-and-older division with a 779 handicapped total, and sits in second place in all-events at 2,108. Schumacher is tied for sixth place in singles at 741 in the 60-to-64 age group and is in 16th place in all-events at 2,084. Bill Kroll, a last-minute replacement on the team, is 11th in singles for the 65-to-69 group with 699.

Apparently, it was "every man for himself," as they don't appear anywhere in the upper echelons of the doubles or team standings. I might suggest that as a team name for next year's tournament in Watertown.

Also interesting is that Schumacher happens to be tied in singles with longtime Sturgeon Bay resident Dave Homan, a state association ambassador and former Door County Bowling Association secretary now living in Wild Rose, near Oshkosh.

Hopefully, Hall will hold on to his singles lead as the tournament plays out to its conclusion April 27. A couple of years ago, Hall won his age group in all-events, garnering a free entry into the USBC Senior Nationals, which was held in Syracuse, N.Y.

This is the 33rd edition of the Wisconsin State Seniors Tournament. While the regular tournament (the 112th edition being held this year in Milwaukee and Menomonee Falls) continues to be the largest state bowling tournament in the country, participation numbers have shrunk a bit since its peak nearly a decade ago. Not so for the seniors, who continue to grow the event geared to bowlers 55 and older in five divisions.

For well over a decade, I went along to state with groups from Sturgeon Bay, but interest waned a few years back. Now, I'm looking forward to qualifying age-wise for next year's senior tournament and find a spot with one of the teams currently making the trip.

That is, if anyone will take me with my handicap-killer average.

Finally, Apple Valley's first annual Two Person Baker Handicapped Tournament took place Jan. 11. In the Baker format (used in high school and college bowling), bowlers alternate frames during each game. Taking home the inaugural championship was the team of Ray Brock and John Rankin. Second place went to Norm and Steve Wipperfurth, with Rose Polcen and Jamie Kerscher in third.

Tourney results

The annual Apple Valley Lanes 9-Pin No-Tap Tournament has concluded for another season. Subject to average verification, the men's division winner was Eric Puyleart and the women's champ was Teresa Wertel — both from Green Bay.

Top Door County finishers included Keith Lauder (third), Randy LeMieux Jr. (sixth) and Todd Cater (eight) among the guys and Jamie Kerscher (eighth) for the gals.

It didn't take long for the second perfect game of the 2013-14 bowling season to be recorded. Scot Hilsabeck started off his night last week in the Wednesday Washout by rolling a 300 on his way to a league-leading 723 series. As did I two weeks earlier, Hilsabeck threw his on lanes 9-10 at Apple Valley Lanes.

This was his second career 300, coming almost exactly six years after the first one on Dec. 12, 2007, also in the Washout. That one was No. 55 in Door County history; this one was No. 101.

Hilsabeck remarked that he wished it had come a week earlier as his team, Cherryland Lube, had fallen to my team in the semifinals of the first-half rollofs in the Washout. Not only did Hilsabeck bowl 217 pins higher this past week, but his team was a total of 560 scratch pins over what they had

bowled a scant week previously.

Moore's 300 is third of his career

John Moore became the eighth Door County bowler to roll a 300 game this season when he achieved perfection during his first game in the Wednesday Night Washout last week at Apple Valley Lanes.

Moore joins Scot Hilsabeck, Bill Kroll, Cubby Hartl, Leif Mickelson, Andy LaLuzerne, Mike Cuculi (twice) and me who have added to the list in 2013-2014.

This was Moore's third career 300 and the 109th overall for Door County bowlers. His first came in the Apple Valley Majors Nov. 26, 2002 (No.

35 overall) and his second on April 5, 2011, also in the Majors (No. 80).

Once again, I had a front row seat as a perfect game was thrown against my team, although I missed the last ball because I was writing down scores. And, not to be snarky or anything, but let's just say that the term "perfect game" referred to the final score, and not all 12 balls of which it consisted.

As they say, though, "You've gotta be good to be lucky."

Moore's effort came two months to the day after Kroll's 300 game in the team event of the association tournament at the Sister Bay Bowl. A total of four perfect games were rolled this season in tournament play, including one each in association doubles (Hartl) and singles (Cuculi) and one at the state tournament (LaLuzerne). The two-month lull came after a flurry of six 300s in the span of three weeks back in January and February.

And, of the five 300s rolled in league play, four have come in the Wednesday Night Washout (the other was part of Leif Mickelson's 803 series in the Northerners at Sister Bay). A shutout in the Apple Valley Majors last occurred a decade ago in the 2003-2004 season when only two perfect games were recorded in Door County — one by Torry Lake in the Cherry Lanes Commercial and the other by Scott Voeks (his career third) in the Sturgeon Bay Industrial.

It feels good to finally join 300 club

Most Wednesday nights at Apple Valley Lanes, my teammates give me grief for writing this column about something that involves me. This week, I have a good excuse.

Last Wednesday night, I became the first Door County bowler to record a 300 during the 2013-14 season. It was the final game of a 762 series that also included a 235 and a 227.

My previous high had been a 288 last season, also in the Washout. That game was the only time I had ever thrown the first 10 strikes in a row. I don't remember what I left in the 11th frame. It must have been a 10-pin, since I missed it.

I had my first inkling that I might end up with a perfect game fairly early. For one thing, I was really throwing the ball well. There hadn't been many cheap ones in the first two games, and I had just made a small move that seemed to be working well as long as I kept my speed up.

The other thing that happened was that Jeff May started giving me the "right of way" when we were both up at the

same time. And not just that — he hung back by the scoring console and watched my delivery (this was in the third or fourth frame).

If I was bowling that good, I must be doing something right.

My only "iffy" ball was in the seventh frame when I got a bit outside my mark. Those shots had been coming back for me all night, but a couple of them had not carried. This one ended up flush in the pocket.

Two things helped when the final frame came along. First, I was in "the zone." I knew that if I kept doing what I had been doing all evening — and especially in the third game — I had a good chance of running them out.

The other thing was that I had also thrown the first nine in a row during a makeup two nights earlier at Willow Creek Lanes. That game, I had

come up light in the pocket and thrown a lot of pins over toward the seven without knocking it over (then I missed it for 267). I was less nervous having been in that situation so soon before.

I don't know who was watching my last three shots, but I think a lot of the guys were. I didn't even want to think. My mindset was pick up my ball, get set and throw. My heart was racing but my knees were solid. Between balls I walked back to our table and put a little more baby powder on my thumb, a ritual for many years before each frame and during pressure situations.

The Washout is a 10-team league, and I was finishing on lane 10. I threw the last ball as well as I had any of the others and "walked it out" a couple of steps to my right. I yelled, "It's got a chance!"

It was solid in the pocket. I remember watching to make sure the 10-pin went down.

It did.

I update the list of Door County Bowling Association 300s and 800s on my computer as I write about them. My 300

just happened to be the 100th thrown over the years by Door County bowlers.

Recently, most of those who have gotten to the final ball have carried it. For some reason, this season has started out differently. Mike Cuculi, Scott Voeks, Randy LeMieux Jr. and Geoff Hansen all had games in the 290s before I broke through. In fact, Hansen had a 297 on the same pair of lanes just the previous evening in the Apple Valley Major.

Having finally rolled a perfect game of my own, I have newfound respect for the skill and luck that goes into that score.

Doc Bundy happened to be in the bar last Wednesday and, like several others I talked to afterward, was surprised to find out that this was only my first 300 game. Doc — who has a 300 of his own — shook my hand and commented on how it was like "becoming part of a fraternity."

Glad to finally get there.

I want to congratulate Andy LaLuzerne for his second career 300, recorded in his opening game of the doubles event at the State Tournament in Milwaukee a couple of weekends ago.

Local bowlers continue to perform well when there's money on the line: seven of the 11 perfect games by Door County kglers over the past year have come in tournament play.

Frankie one pin short of perfection.

Last Tuesday evening in the Apple Valley Majors, Kathy Franke became the first woman in Door County bowling history to achieve one bowling feat and, in the process, almost became the second to record another.

Just six weeks after extending her county women's series record to 753, Franke came within a single pin of a perfect game while rolling the first women's 299 in Door County. Dee Alfson's 300, rolled in the Women's Masters at Apple Valley Lanes on May 2, 2005, remains the only unblemished game to date. Runner-up status to Alfson had been held by Steph Sealey, who threw a 290 game as part of a 720 series in December 2001.

Franke's near-perfect effort came in her first game, which concluded with a 10-pin.



pin," she wrote. "I was hoping for another good series."

"The first eleven were all there, and the last one got just a little wide," she recounted by email. "I threw it well, but a bit 'righter' than it should have been."

It turned out that every strike was needed, as her opponent Mike Cuculi rolled 279 against her in that opening game.

Unfortunately for Franke, the big start did not translate into her second 700 series of the season, as she finished the night at 691.

"I was more disappointed with four splits in the first six frames of the next game than I was about leaving the 10

The head pin bounced off the pit wall, clattered out of the gutter and slowly rolled across the pin deck, toppling the 10-pin on the opposite side of the lane.

That's when I knew that Mike Cuculi would shoot 300.

The lanes were hot. I had already finished off a 258 on the same pair and was writing down scores. It's said that the first ball in the tenth is the toughest. Guys who throw perfect games are often the anchorman, and you've been sitting there thinking while your teammates finish up. Then, when it's your turn, you sometimes try to throw three strikes on the same ball.

The next one is the easy one. Since the first one carried you can keep the line or make corrections based on what you got away with the previous shot. Number 11 was buried.

He was full of nervous energy. "Hey," he smiled. "A good one!"

Cuculi hadn't had a 300 game in almost two years, a near eternity for him. It had only been two

months in coming after the one previous to that. He was due.

He lined up his final shot of the night with the kind of intensity that the best can turn on and off at will. I remember thinking that he was taking longer than I would have expected.

The ball looked good, just like so many others. But I was standing off to one side and didn't see that the line was too tight. High in the pocket, Cuculi left the 6-10 standing for 298.

"Too slow," he muttered as he came off the approach.

"Looked like you tugged it a little," I said.

In the bar afterward, Cuculi told me he felt uncomfortable most of

the night, despite his 298 and a 722 series. He recounted his third game, admitting that "there were only three or four good ones in there." Even bowling next to him last Wednesday, I hadn't much noticed that they weren't all buried.

I supposed that this sort of thing had only happened to him once or twice — going to the last ball and not making it. He didn't know the exact number, but was sure it was more than that. Usually a guy with multiple 300 games gets one when he's in a groove and has complete confidence in his shot, but it still takes some luck along with the talent.

Cuculi has a lot of the

Mickelson started his series with his third career 300 game and then kept going with a 256 and a 247 — all the way to the first ever 800 series recorded at the Bowl, an 803.

Mickelson, a 2011 inductee into the Door County USBC Hall of Fame, has long been

one of the best bowlers in the area and a top performer on the lanes in Sister Bay. It had been a long time between perfect games, however. Mickelson became the first in county history to notch two career 300s on March 4, 1998 (following his first on December 13, 1995). His third came almost 16 years later.

For the record, his three perfectos are Nos. 14, 21 and 105 in county bowling annals. A total of nine 300s have now been shot at the bowl; the others were by Jason Daubner

(2010), Don Dietrich (2003), Tom Demmin (1999), Jim Yocum (1995), Don Ray (1986) and Emery Larson (1966).

Mickelson's 803 series was the second 800 of the 2013-14 season, following another 803 by Scott Voeks in the Apple Valley Majors on Sept. 10, and was the 29th in Door County history. His score erased the previous house record of 773 set by Daubner on Nov. 11, 2010 — also with the aid of a 300 game noted in the previous paragraph.

The perfect game shot by Mickelson, how-

ever, was the third in three days. The other two came during the first weekend of the Door County USBC tournament at Apple Valley Lanes.

Aaron (Cubby) Hart rolled his first career 300 in the doubles event Sunday, Jan. 19. Mike Cuculi made it an even dozen for his career in the singles event just a bit later. Cuculi had gone more than two years without finding perfection on the lanes but once again holds a three-game edge over Scott Voeks, who has nine to his credit.

Franke 'stoked' with record

With so much going on in Door County bowling, I'm actually going to have to postpone the team event and all-events reports from the Door County USBC Association Tournament for another week.

Let's just say for now that next year, we should all chip in to buy Mike Snell a month-long vacation somewhere right around this time so that the rest of us have a chance.

The middle of February has been portentous for Door County women's bowling, as every 700 series they have recorded since 2009 has come at this time of the season. Last week, Kathy Franke extended her Door County USBC women's series record by rolling a 753 in the Apple Valley Majors on games of 265-244-244.

Franke is no stranger to high scores, having both 300 games and 800 series to her credit while bowling in the Green Bay and Milwaukee associa-

tions earlier in her career. And, although she now holds an even dozen of the 27 series of 700 or better by Door County women, she told me by e-mail, "It was fun. It's been such a long, long time since I've bowled like that, I just figured those days were behind me. I'm still pretty stoked."

Franke's last 700 series was a 704 in the Women's Masters three years ago. Last week's record was also the first 700 in the Door County USBC since Michelle Pfannenstiel rolled a 702 in the Apple Valley Classic Feb. 18 last year. The previous mark of 736 had stood since Franke bowled the association's eighth 700 in the Apple Dumplings way back during the 1998-1999 season.

Perhaps the most impressive aspect of her performance was that it was the only 700 series in the Majors last week, a predominantly male league that recorded no less than six 700s the week prior.

Sevastopol places 13th at state tournament

I walked into Ashwaubenon Lanes Friday evening to watch qualifying for the 2014 Wisconsin High School Bowling Club State Championships just in time to see Sevastopol's team begin its fourth of fifteen games — a 148 marked by a combination of splits and missed spares.

It was by far the Pioneers' worst game of the evening.

Soon after, the splits went away and the strikes came with more regularity. Sevastopol averaged almost 200 over its final two blocks of five games to finish with a total of 2,893 — good for a respectable 13th place out of 23 teams in Division 2.

I bowled some practice games at Ashwaubenon prior to the start of the season, and found their synthetic approaches to be so sticky that I could barely stand up during my delivery. I'm sure that our bowlers found the footing similarly confounding, especially compared to Apple Valley Lanes, which has slicker wood approaches.

Not to say that some of the team's shortcom-



ings weren't self-inflicted.

It looked to me like Sevastopol may have been a bit slow to react to the oil moving down the lane in the early going. The team left several "bucket" combinations on light hits and missed some single-pin spares in the left-hand corner to the inside.

Spare conversions are the bane of many a young bowler, and missing single pins can be extremely frustrating. For instance, Sevastopol failed on two 10 pins and a seven-pin in game 12, costing it 35 pins that would have turned its 183 into a 218 (everything else being equal, of course).

Sevastopol ended up 192 pins from making the stepladder finals as the fifth-place team. Although that sounds like a lot, it averages out to just 12.8 pins per game. A

missed single-pin spare in between two strikes loses 12 pins. It's easy to see that the Pioneers were a lot closer to advancing than one might think.

Nick Cater did well in the anchor spot, more often than not doubling in the 10th frame for a strong finish. The rest of the team (Joey Plaszkievicz, Mandy Plaszkievicz, Jacob Cater, Jared Meyer and Danny Hanson) had their ups and downs; there were a lot of pretty good hits all around that resulted in nine counts.

The top Division 2 qualifier was Elkhart Lake-Glenbulah (3,375 — 225.0), which lost the title match to No. 3 Kewaskum. The top qualifier in Division 1 was Kenosha Tremper (3,440 — 229.3) — also losing to the No. 3 qualifier from Sheboygan. The Division 1 girls champs were a conglomerate team from the West Allis/Brookfield area. Division 2 went to Antigo.

Holly Minahan and Joey Plaszkievicz were the singles qualifiers from our area. Minahan rolled a 546 (166-192-188),

but the cut to the top 25 percent was 637 and stepladders 1,286 after three more games. The winner was top qualifier Stephanie Schwartz of Racine, who shot 764 and then 708, then beat Brittany Burgess of Fond du Lac in a rolloff after tying the title match at 237.

Plaszkievicz didn't make the boys cut, which was at 669; 1,438 for stepladders. The top two qualifiers, Scott Brau Jr. of Racine (753-755) and Tyler Sheehy of Sun Prairie (763-739) met for championship match, won by Brau 260-216.

Thanks again to our local high school club bowling coaches, Bob Nelson for Sevastopol and Carl Beckstrom for Minahan and Southern Door — plus Bill Hall and Tim Jutila who each coached a team for Sturgeon Bay.
