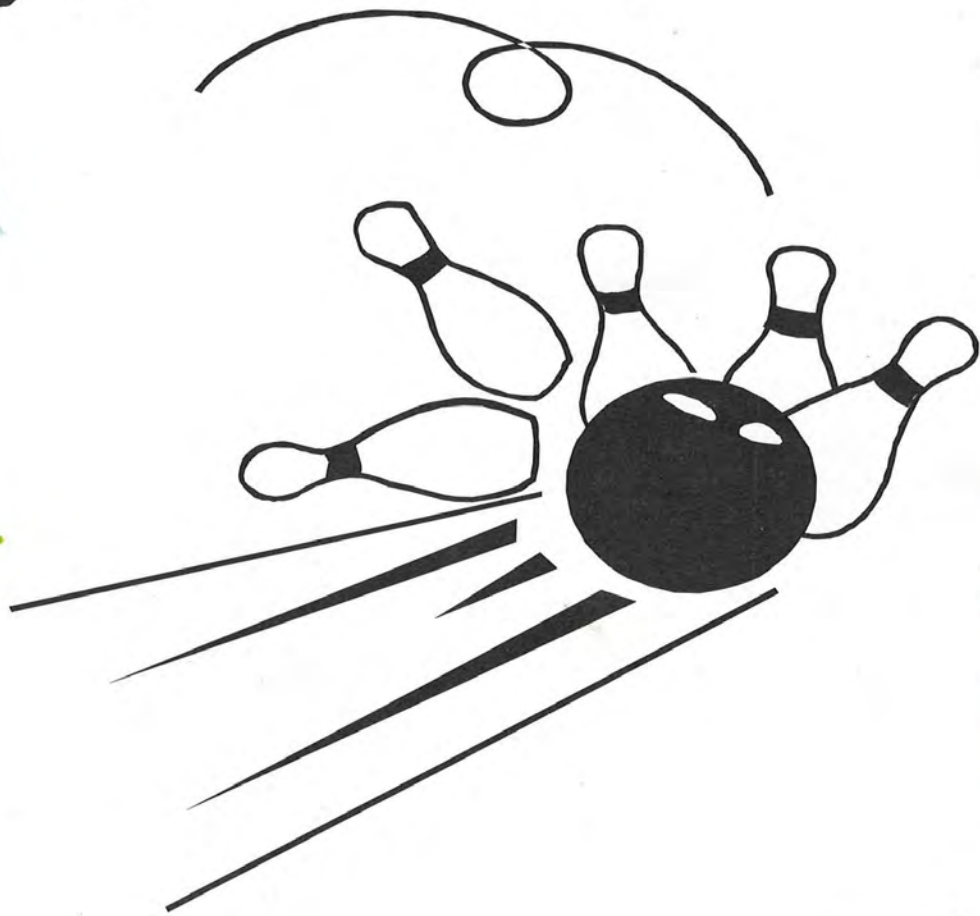

## DOOR COUNTY USBC ANNUAL DELEGATES MEETING

April 16, 2012 Apple Valley Lanes

President *Barnie Haen* called the meeting to order at 6:04 p.m.

Roll call showed *Todd Jacobe, Rose Polcen, Tracy VanLanen, Jim Regner, and Mike Daubner* present.

*Dave Wanke, Michelle Pfannenstiel, John Moore and Brandon Kinjerski* were absent.

League Delegates present were: *David Franke of the Apple Dumplings, Rick Davis of Apple Valley Majors & Wednesday Washouts, Todd Jacobe of the Early Sunday Mixed, Linda Jarman of the Northernettes, Mike Daubner of the Sister Bay Tavern League, Jamie Kerscher of the Women's Masters and Barnie Haen of the Sunday Adult/Youth.*

The following leagues were not represented: *Apple Valley Classic, Odd Couples, Sturgeon Bay Industrial, and Women's Apple Corps.*

Secretary's report of April 11, 2011 was presented in written form and summarized. No changes or additions were suggested. Motion to accept as written by *Tracy VanLanen*, second by *Rose Polcen*, passed.

Financial Report, including HOF and Tournament financial statements, and Membership information were presented in written form. The financial report showed all deposits and expenses for sanctions, Hall of Fame Banquet and the County Tournament. Detailed financial reports from the Hall of Fame and the County Tournament were also distributed and showed the HOF to have cost the Association \$113.82. With a change in awards to help contain costs, we saved \$70. The Tournament statement is at even. The membership chart shows a decrease in sanctions of about 50, which has resulted in a decrease in revenue of \$300. Motion to accept as presented by *Rick Davis*, second by *Jim Regner*, passed.

### Committee Reports

***Finance*** (*Barnie\**, *Jim, Kathy*): All has been reviewed and is in order. Monthly bank statements are forwarded to the President on a monthly basis and all checks now have 2 signatures, President and Association Manager. Financial statements show all pertinent information and always balance.

***Youth*** (*Michelle*): unable to attend meeting - report attached.

***Hall of Fame*** (*Kathy\**, *Barnie, Michelle, Rose, Tracy, Pat*): We held our 6<sup>th</sup> Annual Hall of Fame banquet on 10/22/11 with 75 people in attendance. *Leif Mickelson* and *Tony Peot* were inducted into the Hall of Fame for Superior Performance and *Jeremy Wheat* and *Ashley Kinnard-Carstens* were honored as our Junior Bowlers of the Year. *Scott Dix* was recognized for his 1<sup>st</sup> ever 800 series, an 818. *John Moore* and *Jason Daubner* were awarded one-time 300 awards for their 1<sup>st</sup> ever perfect games. County Tournament winners and Association High Game, High Series, High Average and Most Improved Average winners were also honored. Special guest *Joe Boulanger* from the Men's State Association was in attendance. Our banquet for this year is tentatively set for Saturday, October 20, 2012.

This year we also ran 50/50 raffles in all our leagues to raise money for a new Hall of Fame cabinet that now has enough room to display new inductees for several years. It was built by league bowler, *Geoff Hansen*.

**Tournament** (Dave\*, Jim, Todd, John, Brandon, Mike): This year's tournament saw 7 Division 1 teams and 9 Division 2 teams, 11 Division 1 doubles and 16 Division 2 doubles, 25 Division 1 singles and 24 Division 2 singles, and 21 Division 1 all-events and 12 Division 2 all-events. Fifteen (15) women bowled. The committee raised \$855 from sponsors and \$488 from 50/50 raffles. Combined with \$367 from membership fees (\$1 per member) and the prize portion of the entry fees, there was \$3405 in the prize fund. For awards, \$426 has been set aside for 16 prizes including sponsor plaques for the team events. Checks have all been distributed. All tournament awards will be presented at the Hall of Fame banquet in October.

**Nominating** (Tracy\*, Dave, Mike, Rose): The following positions were up for re-election: Vice President Dave Wanke, Director/Youth Representative Michelle Pfannenstiel, Director Todd Jacobe and Director John Moore. Dave and John did not seek re-election.

A slate was not presented at this time. The nominating committee will field names and Bernie will appoint new directors at the August meeting. Mike will talk with his bowlers this week and try to get at least one.

The Board wishes to thank Dave Wanke and John Moore for their many years of service. **Thank You!!**

#### **Delegates Reports**

- A. Bernie attended the Annual Meeting in January in Wausau. Entries for the 2012 Men's State Tournament are down slightly, but are increasing quite a bit for the Senior State. Hall of Fame Banquet and inductions were also held. Gary D. & Dale Traber from Milwaukee were inducted. There were 5 \$1000 Youth scholarships awarded. The State is currently working on getting a High School bowling program started. Next year's Senior State will be held in La Crosse. There was no voting on bylaw changes.
- B. Linda attended the Women's State Annual Meeting in March. Her report is attached.

#### **New Business**

- A. Suggestions/Feedback from Delegates: There was discussion regarding the significant drop in membership this year and how to get more people to bowl. State Delegate Linda Jarman works at the YMCA and will post bowling notices there. League Delegate Rick Davis will also post bowling notices at the college he is attending. Board Members Tracy and Rose will be talking to several women interested in bowling the State Tournament about joining a league here. Board Member Todd will research posting our Association on Facebook with links to Apple Valley's website and to Sister Bay's when they get one. Board Member Mike Daubner will try and persuade his Wednesday couples league to sanction. He knows some of the bowlers who would like to be sanctioned. He is also working on starting a Junior program at his house.

Motion to adjourn by David Franke, seconded by Todd Jacobe, passed. Meeting adjourned at 6:47 p.m.

2012 WISCONSIN STATE USBC WOMEN'S BOWLING ASSN. ANNUAL MEETING  
Ho-Chunk Hotel & Convention Center  
Baraboo, WI

The convention started Friday evening, with the Wis. Women Bowling Writers meeting. President Sandy Lally thanked all committee members, and encouraged everyone to get involved in the poster, photography, and writing contests (feature story and news). Secretary/Treasurer Kandy Birmingham that we now have a record breaking membership of 155 members, with 106 members and three guests attending the meeting.

Bonnie Decker, chair, announced that \$696. was raised for cancer research through the Mail-O-Graphic Tournament. All USBC bowlers are welcome to participate in this tournament. Information can be found on the WWBW website.

After committee reports and contest awards were given, the meeting adjourned at 8:03 PM.

The Wis. Women's 500 Bowling Club meeting started immediately after the Bowling Writers meeting. There were 98 members and seven guests in attendance, and membership now stands at 1,177.

President Lucy Bergman announced the 2011 tournament winners and handed out awards. This years tournament will be held at Rose Bowl Lanes in Marshfield beginning October 6. This years tournament featured penalty shots when you got a split. Some of the 208 who participated say it was a real challenge to keep bowling after having too many penalties! Any woman who has ever had a 500 series is welcome to join for a lifetime membership fee of \$10.00. The meeting adjourned at 9:00 PM.

The Wis. Women's 600 Club meeting was held at 7:30 Saturday morning. I didn't attend, as I'm not a member, and it was way too early to move! I do know that 135 attended the meeting, and that the 2012 tourney will be in LaCrosse, and 2013's will be in Shawano. More information can be obtained at [www.wisconsin600club.org](http://www.wisconsin600club.org) regarding tournaments and membership.

The Association meeting was opened by President Kandy Birmingham at 10:00 AM. The morning session included welcomes from Milwaukee and Baraboo, the presentation of Association President and Manager awards, and the induction of Lynn Tyree-Cook of Milwaukee into the Hall of Fame for Superior Performance. Four first time 300 & one 800 bowler(s) were introduced. One first time 300 bowler was 73 years old, proving that sometimes you have to bowl a long time to get 'the prize'.

President Birmingham announced the exciting news that in May and June of 2013 the first Midwest Women's Bowling Tournament will be held in Lansing, MI. She and the ladies of

four other states have worked long and hard to bring this to fruition. The following states will host: 2014 - Indiana, 2015 - Illinois, 2016 - Iowa, 2017 - Ohio, and 2018 - Wisconsin. Needless to say, USBC is watching this tournament very closely. Plans are already in the works to charter buses from Milwaukee for the tournament, and possibly some from Green Bay. She also reported that delegates at the national convention will be voting on whether to give USBC "financial freedom" to allow the board of directors to set national dues without delegate votes. Currently it is sent to association presidents and managers.

Manager Pat Tebon presented the financial and tournament reports. We are still the largest women's tournament in the nation, with 1,900 bowlers.

After lunch, the memorial service was held, followed by committee reports. There were 233 members eligible to vote. The Jeannette Kneppreth Scholarship committee gave out ten \$1,000.00 awards. Remember, any relative of a bowler may apply for this scholarship.

An hilarious skit was presented by Bonnie Piezchek and Cindy Kuchenreuther, (Pres. Daughter). It can be viewed on the WWBW Facebook page, and is well worth your time. Information on all tournaments was presented. Reports were given by all Club presidents, and the meeting adjourned at 4:00 PM.

Besides attending meetings, I was honored to be a teller at this year's convention, and also manned the Badger Queens raffle table. On Sunday morning I attended the question and answer session along with 170 other women. Other than minor rule questions, the only 'glitch' was one woman who opposed the skit being presented at a business meeting (only the Sgt. at Arms and I knew about it.) She was promptly booed for her lack of sensitivity. The skit was about a doctor and nurse. For those who don't know, Kandy's daughter Cindy is fighting colon cancer that had spread to her liver before it was discovered. (Cindy had almost all of her liver removed the end of March, and is holding her own. This after colon surgery and five months of chemo.)

## BOWLING COLUMN

# Tidbits from state delegates meeting

One event that takes place during opening weekend of the state tournament is the annual delegates meeting. As representative from the Door County USBC, I can report that:

The new state association manager is Don Hildebrand, who comes from the Milwaukee area USBC. His "apprenticeship" to retiring manager Phil LaPorte will run through August.

Although the Wisconsin State Senior Tournament continues to grow by leaps and bounds, the regular tournament is beginning to show some dropoff in participation. The state association is looking for ways to encourage younger bowlers (ages 20 to 40) to get involved in the tournament. Baby Boomers like myself are the ones now flocking to the senior tourney (although I won't be eligible until I hit 55 in a few years).

Five Ted Jaskie Scholarships are awarded every year to youth bowlers in Wisconsin who are seniors in high school. The scoring system behind the \$1,000 awards has been revamped to put more emphasis on the "scholar" in scholarship — specifically in the essay on "How Bowling Has Effectuated My Life," which now counts for 250 of 350 total points. High school and bowling performance each count for 50 points.

I would like to take a moment to point out that the title of the required essay is copied directly from the application form.

Anyway, I'll make a few copies of the application and get them out to Apple Valley Lanes. The deadline is April 1, and only 37 applications were received last year, so the odds aren't too bad for area seniors.



Here's some interesting info on Wisconsin/Upper Michigan bowling associations. There are 68 associations that have merged men, women and youth together into one unit. Door County, with 425 sanctioned bowlers last season is one of them — and the 26th largest. Our youth bowlers are actually members of the Green Bay Association, which is not merged. There are 53 men's associations, 50 women's and 38 youth associations which are still operating independently. In fact, only about one third of Wisconsin bowlers are currently in merged associations.

Saturday evening, I attend-

ed the annual Wisconsin State USBC Hall of Fame banquet. There were four inductees this year, although Gary Daroszewski was actually elected last year, but couldn't make the banquet due to unforeseen circumstances. Daroszewski won four state titles and six at nationals, each of which is quite an achievement. In fact, he was also elected to the National Hall of Fame this past year for his tournament accomplishments.

Joining him in the Skilled Division of the hall was Dale Traber. Traber bowled on the PBA Tour — as did his brother, Dave. Unfortunately, the first time Dale made the TV finals his opponent was ... yep, Dave. Although Traber never won on the regular tour, he took home the top prize in two Senior Tour events in 2009 and 2011. Traber and Daroszewski were teammates for many years on the famous Linds bowling team.

New this year to the Hall of Fame was the "Exemplary Service" Division. The first two inductees were Tony Piantek and Bill Marescalco Jr. Piantek sent squads of 20 teams to the state tournament for two decades as secretary of the Neenah association, which hosted five state tournaments. He was also a longtime state director, and president in 2004.

Next year's regular tournament will be held in Fond du Lac, with the senior event in La Crosse. Hope some of you out there can make it to state.

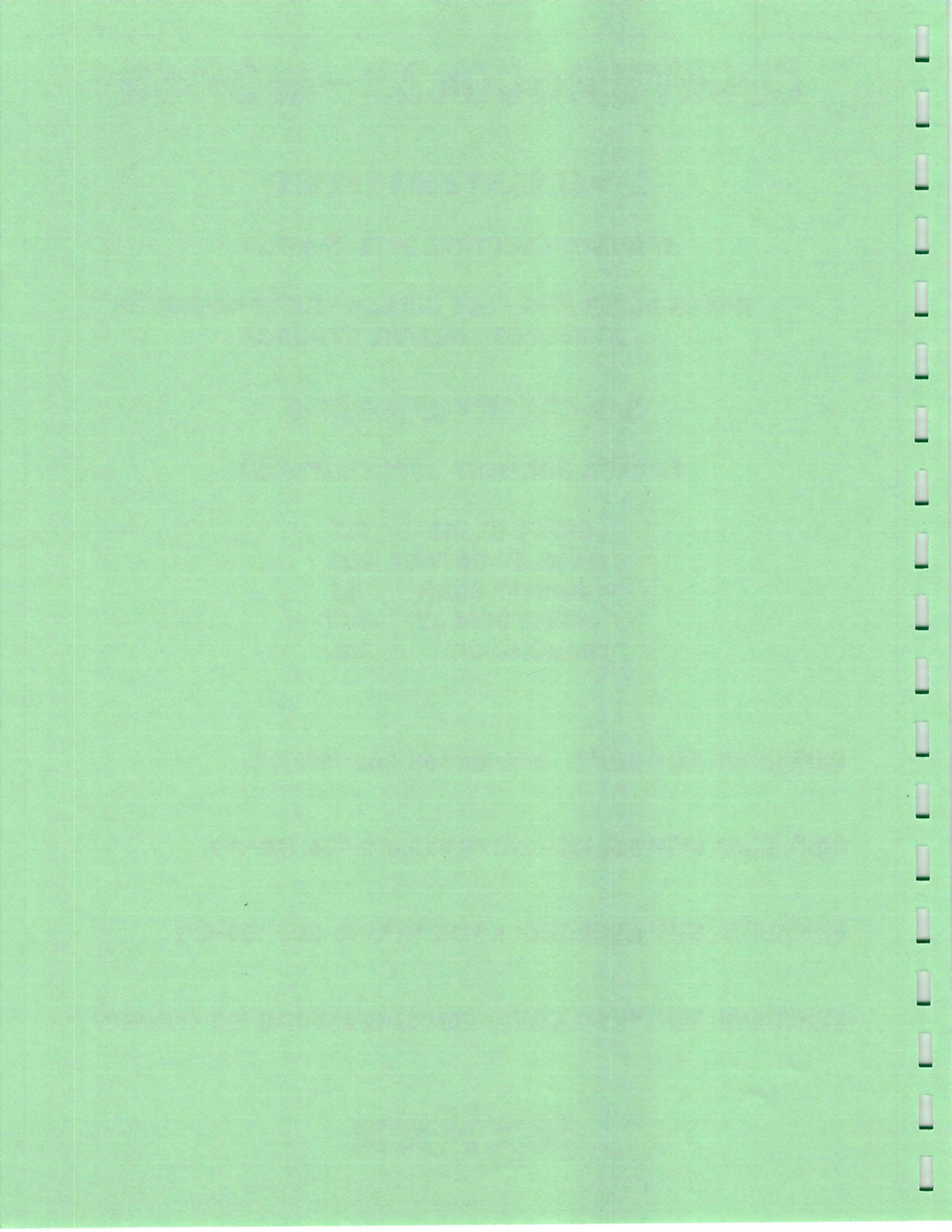

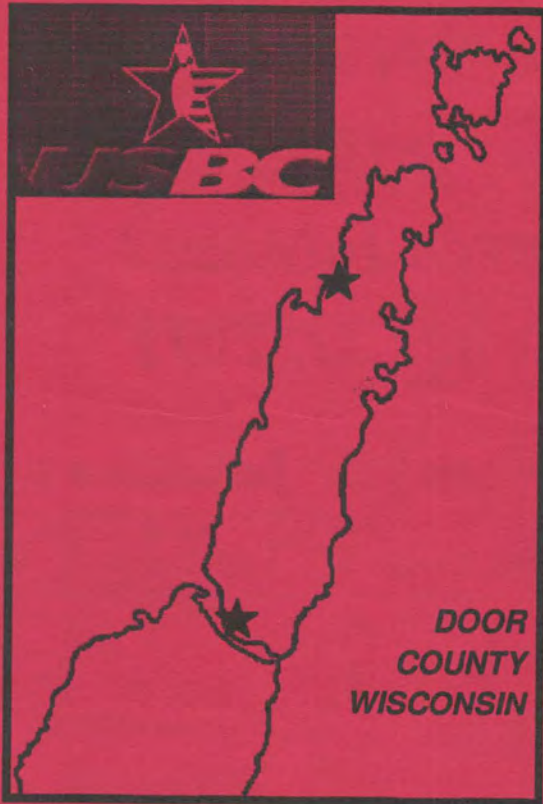

# Peot, Mickelson roll way into Hall of Fame

**T**ony Peot of Sturgeon Bay and Leif Mickelson of Baileys Harbor will be inducted into the Door County Bowling Hall of Fame during an awards banquet Saturday night at the Draft Haus in Sturgeon Bay.

Peot may be the last male bowler inducted into the Hall in the superior performance category without a 300 game or 800 series to his credit. But from the late 1980s and through the 1990s, there was no better bowler in Door County. His smooth delivery and exceptional accuracy put him at or near the top of the annual average book year after year.

Bowling at Worley's and Apple Valley Lanes, Peot anchored many championship teams in the toughest men's leagues. His 217 high average in the 1989-90 season was the best in association history until he bettered it at 219 in 1993-94. At a time when a single 700 series during a bowling season was still considered a major accomplishment, Peot authored five such outings in 1996-97.

His career high of 789 would have been the first 800 in Door County history, had he run out his last game for 300 (he left the four-pin in the 11th). His high game of 299 came on Jan. 14, 2000, and he won several association tournament titles, including singles and all-events in 1988. He was doubles champion with Eddy Allen one season, a feat that Eddy appreciates to this day.

Leif Mickelson was the first Door County bowler to record two perfect games — both shot at the Sister Bay Bowl, on Dec. 13, 1995, and March 4, 1998. Over 23 years, Mickelson has established himself as one of the top bowlers in Door County, and consistently ranks in the top three averages in Sister Bay, where he has recorded in excess of 15 700 series on tough conditions.

When comparing talents from different bowling establishments — where varying conditions come into play — it is often useful to consider performances on a common stage. Mickelson has excelled come tournament time in Door County, notching eight titles over the years: four in the team event, three in doubles and one in all-events. For good measure, he also won the now-defunct scratch option of the tournament, the Door County Cup, in 1996 (defeating me in the finals, I might add).

Also on the program is recognition of the Junior Bowlers of the year, Jeremy Wheat and Ashley Kinnard-Carstens; 300 game, 800 series and high average honors; and awards to the winners of this past season's association tournament. Tickets for the event are available at local bowling centers.

# So Long Dickie-Doo

## *Remembering the kindness of Dick Daubner*

**T**he sun is not as bright, the laughs are not as loud, and the smiles are not as wide in Sister Bay today.

Dick Daubner, one of the village's most beloved personalities, died in his home June 29 at the age of 65.

Dick wasn't one of the owners of the Sister Bay Bowl, but for years many customers, including myself, thought that he was. That's because when Dickie-doo was behind the bar, the room was his.

A "What'll ya have?" from Dick was a Sister Bay salutation.

When I first stepped behind the bar to sling beers and Manhattan's at The Bowl in 2004, Dick had already left to take his shot at Maxwellton Braes. I quickly learned what big shoes lingered – shoes that made my feet look like a child's.

"Where's Dick tonight?" was a common question, even years after he stopped bartending on those packed Friday nights.

Outside The Bowl you always knew when Dick entered the room, not because he was loud and obnoxious, but because he had friends everywhere and as soon as he stepped through the door one of them was sure to holler "Dickie-doo!"

Then you'd hear that unmistakable voice, always sounding like it was smothered in a head cold, respond with a big laugh and a "Heeeyyy there (insert name of one of a thousand friends here)!"

"He probably knows more people up here than anyone," said his good friend Dick Wegman. "He was so unpretentious, just one of the nicest guys that walked the face of the earth."

Dick loved his family and he loved following the athletic teams of his alma mater, Gibraltar High School. He loved Sunday boat rides to the island and grabbing dinner with his wife and closest friends.

And he loved to tell stories from his familiar perch on a coveted barstool at the bubble of the end of the bar at The Bowl.

That's the place where, more often than not, I knew I could find him on a Friday night finishing up a perch plate and laughing with his wife Sharon, or over the lunch hour catching up on the latest news.

When I needed perspective on a story I always knew I could find it on the stools of The Bowl. It's where anecdotes, secrets, and something close to the truth hang out. Over the years, Dick provided me with plenty of each.

He'd help me decipher who the best bowlers were and which high school basketball team would have beaten another. He could give you the backstory at the root of local politics and plenty of background one could never print. And he was great for a "you know who you should talk to about that is..." – one of the most valuable sentences a reporter could hear.

Some nights the conversation would take a lot of stops and starts, interrupted by so many friends and family swinging around the bar to say hello.

But I didn't mind waiting around if Dick was there.

"Get him one on me will ya?" was a phrase familiar to anyone who knew Dick well. He was so generous that Wegman wondered how they ever made any money at The Bowl when he was bartending.

"On a big Friday night if he was bartending he might take in like \$12," Wegman joked.

So I'd sit there and let him buy me a beer, or two, of course, as people came by to slap him on the back and shake his hand. He'd look over his shoulder to see who was there and upon recognition you'd get a "Oh hi-ya! How are ya!"

Everyone got a big hello from Dickie-doo. If Dick wasn't happy to see you, you had to be some kind of a jerk.

It wasn't that Dick held court rattling off jokes, cracking on his buddies, or preaching on the news of the day. There was something much more simple about him.

There was nice, and then there was Dick Daubner nice.

An imperfectly perfect smile almost always graced his face, whether he was behind the bar, bowling, or bouncing around JJ's playing the polka cello late on a Fall Fest Sunday.

Over the years I've had to say goodbye to many friends and community members on these pages. In doing so I try in some way to add up accomplishments, associations, and the things people had a hand in building.

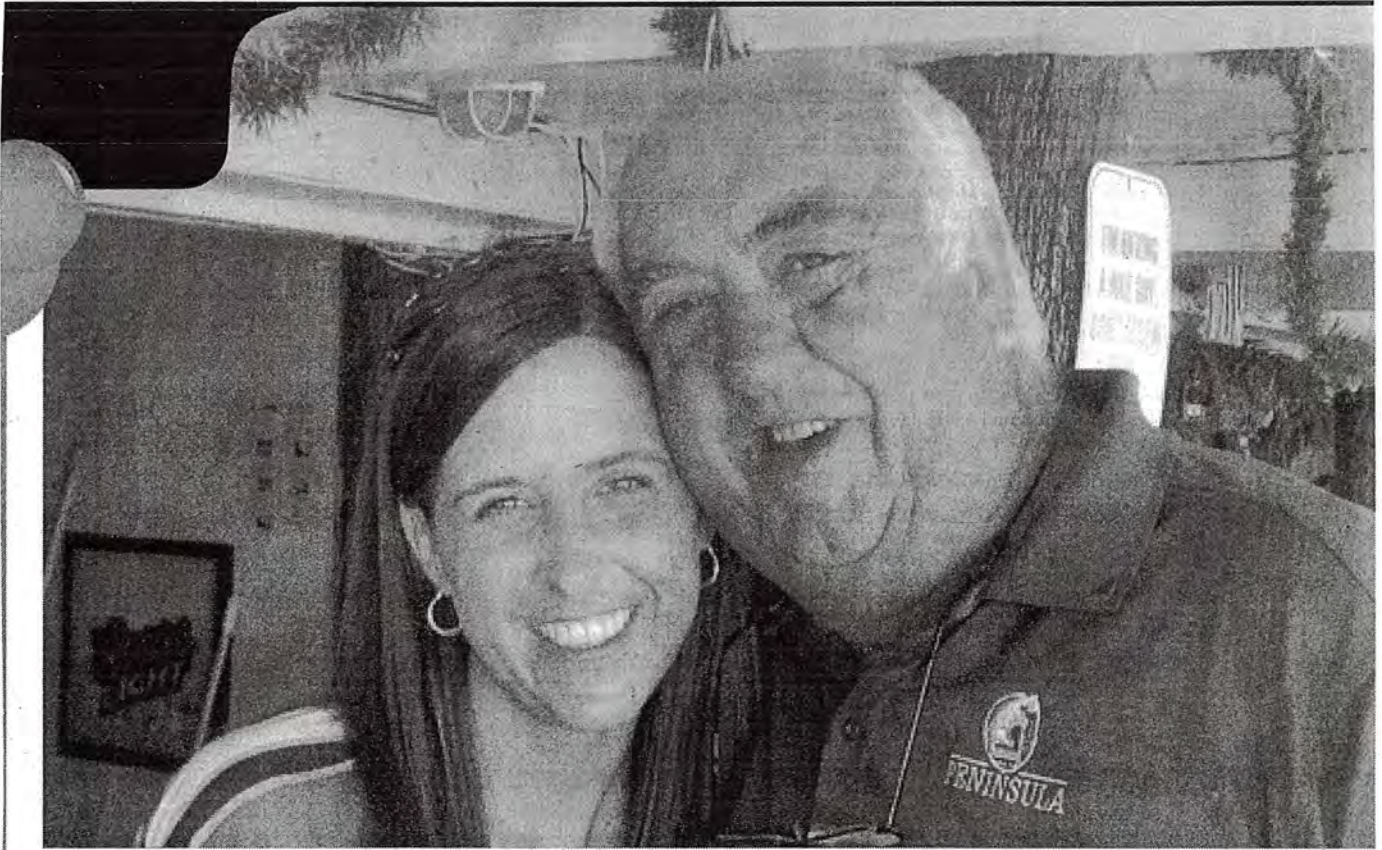
I could list those with Dick, but they seem wholly inadequate. They don't do much to measure a man whose impact was tied so closely to the feeling he gave so many. In the wake of his passing there are so many people young and old who are heartbroken.

When he passed away on Friday he left behind his wife Sharon, his sons Jason (Tori) and Michael (Meghan), daughter Michelle, and his brother Ron (Lynn). He left behind his granddaughters Sarah and Emma, mother-in-law Rita, and a huge extended family.

And he left Sister Bay with a host of great memories – big laughs, little kindnesses, great parties, and an introduction to one of the weirdest instruments you'll ever hear.

Above everything he leaves hundreds of lives much better for having had him in them.

So long Dickie-doo. We miss you already.

Amazingly, Mike Cuculi came close to duplicating the feat on the same lane as the very next bowler. Cuculi also left the Big Four standing, and also slid the 6-pin across the lane to take out the 7-pin but didn't get the carry with the 4-pin.

I had similar luck both weekends of the tournament — two iffy games followed by a big game that made me wish I had bowled better the first two games. I had a 245 finish on weekend one for 586 and a 256 final game on weekend two for 608.

In fact, a recurring theme of the tournament was bowlers who just couldn't put three good games together. Even Jacobe and Dix with their 700s had one game that was decidedly lower than the other two.

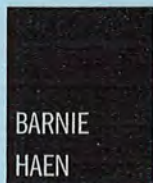

## Cuculi rolls 10th perfect game

Several local bowlers are off to impressive early starts this season, but none like Door County USBC hall of famer Mike Cuculi.

Cuculi topped off an 813 series with a perfect game last Wednesday night in the Washout League at Apple Valley Lanes.

Adam Kring, who bowls with him, recounted that Cuculi left the 10-pin and nine-pin on successive balls to open his evening, then ran the rest out for a 279. The 300 game on the end followed a relatively pedestrian 235 middle game. I guess a 235 can be thought unremarkable, in that Cuculi is averaging 255 for his first six games of the season on Wednesdays.

The 800 series was Cuculi's fifth, with four coming in leagues and one in tournament play. The count fell a single pin shy of a personal-best 814 shot in September of 2009 and 11 short of the association record 825 by Scott Voeks. It was the 15th 800-plus series overall in Door County bowling history.

Cuculi also became the first bowler to reach double



digits in perfect games recorded in the Door County USBC. His 10th 300 was the 81st rolled in the local association.

I can attest to the fact that the last two balls of the 300 were solid in the pocket, as I was several lanes over from the excitement on lanes 9 and 10 and didn't notice Cuculi's perfect game attempt until it was near completion. Despite the gaudy scoring records detailed above, Cuculi had been in a short drought, having gone the entire 2010-11 season without a 300 or 800 to his credit.

Something I thought was interesting as I watched his final shots was the degree of concentration Cuculi put into each delivery. He even backed off before his 11th ball when he caught a distraction out of the corner of his eye. The standard logic when you're on the verge of a perfect game is to let mus-

cle memory overcome nervousness. If you spend too much time on the approach, you're liable to outthink yourself.

However, when you've been to the mountaintop as many times as Cuculi has, nerves aren't as big a factor as execution. Superb concentration is a hallmark of those who excel at any activity — and especially in sports. The extra time Cuculi spent on his mental checklist before throwing those last shots sets him and other supremely talented bowlers apart from those of us among the rank and file.

I was working in the kitchen at Apple Valley — as I usually do on Tuesday evenings — when I heard a shout from the lanes.

I found out that Geoff Hansen had just rolled his second perfect game of the season. As I went back to the grill, I thought, "Well, about the only thing that hasn't happened yet this season is two 300s in one night."

And three minutes later, Todd Cater finished off his 300 game.

- Same game.
- Same pair.
- Same team.

# Little separated Voeks from record night

In my last column, I detailed how Mike Cuculi rolled his second perfect game of the young season on his way to a career-best 821 series in the Apple Valley Majors. Cuculi achieved that score despite having two open frames over the course of the evening.

One week later in the same league, Scott Voeks began his night with the first 18 strikes in a row, covered a single-pin spare in the seventh frame of the second game, and then ran the last five for a 300-279 start. He finished his series "clean" — meaning he went the whole night without an open frame.

"Wow!" you're probably thinking. "What incredible score did he shoot?"

Didn't even get to 800.

Voeks left six single pins in the first seven frames of his third game and, even though he covered all of them and ended with a very respectable 215, his total of 794 must have left him feeling a bit frustrated. Having 27 strikes out of 35 first balls and nine counts on the other eight just didn't add up.

So far this season, Voeks had been relatively quiet. Not that his week-in week-out performance left something to be desired, as his average of 227 in the Majors was just a pin or two behind Cuculi for the league lead. He just hadn't put up an eye-catching number all year.

Even more surprising is that this was Voeks' first perfect game in three full years. Consulting association records, I discovered that he shot his sixth 300 on Veteran's Day, 2008. His county record 825, rolled on Dec. 18 of last year, didn't contain a 300 (269-288-288). It did, however, consist of 29 strikes, five spares and an eight count on a fill ball.

Just two more strikes in the right place meant the difference between 794 and the county record. For instance, turn the nine counts Voeks left in the sixth and seventh frames of his third game into strikes, and he ends up with a 246 final game and — 825.

The 300 game was the fourth this season in the Door County USBC and No. 84 overall. It's beginning to look like our relative drought in perfectos from last season has ended.

Heck. I might even get one.

Jacobe's first perfect game came at the state tournament. If you're going to throw a big game, there's no better time to do it than when there's some money riding on it.

# Perfect games keep rolling in Door County

Well, the perfect-game count has hit double digits for the 2011-12 bowling season in Door County. The latest to perform the feat was T.J. Lautenbach on Feb. 20 in the Apple Valley Classic.

That was one day after Todd Jacobe rolled the second of his career in the singles event of the Door County Bowling Association Tournament.

Which was four days after Rick Davis shot his second of the season in the Wednesday Night Washout.

Which was one week after Davis' first — also in the Washout.

Which was one night after Scott Voeks had his second of the season in the Apple Valley Majors.

Which was six days after Chris Greninger had his second career perfect in the Washout.

Which was on Feb. 1.

That's six 300 games in the space of twenty days — an onslaught unheard of here in Door County. Six perfect games is usually a full season's worth for us; last season, we only had three total.

What could be causing this

plethora of pins? This surfeit of strikes? This excess of Xs?

What do all these bowlers have in common?

Well, for one thing, none of them are me.

By that, I mean that the bowlers performing these scoring feats aren't 52-year-old guys with a bad knee and tendinitis in his thumb.

Not to say that they're young — all the bowlers listed above are in their 30s or 40s, except for maybe T.J. But they throw the ball like they're young — a lot of speed, fingers and power.

Because lane conditions do not change as fast and as much as they used to a decade — or even five years — ago, it's not unusual for someone with a hot hand to find 12 frames in a row where they have a great shot to the pocket. Every once in a while, those 12 frames just happen to all be in the same game.

## Hansen rolls 300

Geoff Hansen rolled Door County's second perfect game of the season Oct. 11 in the Apple Valley Majors. The 300 was Hansen's first of his career, topping a 296 game shot in the association tournament a couple of years ago, and was the 82nd perfect game in Door County USBC history. Hansen threw his perfect on the same pair — lanes 9 and 10 — as Mike Cuculi a month earlier. Hansen's 757 series also led the league.

Jeff Isaksen was chosen as Bowler of the Month for September at Apple Valley Lanes. Isaksen opened his season with a 725 series.

And from the "Don't try this at home" file comes a report that Gordy Swiggum found an unusual way to jump-start his bowling game. According to his wife, Shelby, Gordy had a slightly irregular heartbeat. Doctors gave him a cardiac jolt at 7 a.m., and he was back on the lanes for his 1 p.m. seniors league. Not only is it amazing that he was able to bowl, but Swiggum shot 593 with a 220 game.

Swiggum does not recommend the procedure and suggests that throwing a few practice games would be much more pleasant and offer longer term improvement.

Games in the 270s are relatively common today in many men's leagues here in Door County. Each of those games is one or two strikes away from perfection. Granted, the pressure is a lot higher the farther you go with all strikes, but how many other 300s have been short-circuited by a ringing 10-pin or a stone-seven somewhere along the way?

And even a 52-year-old guy with a bad knee and tendinitis in his thumb can throw 11 strikes out of 12 once in a while, like I did earlier this season with a 278 game in the Washout.

It will be interesting to see what our final total is before it's all over in April.

## Greninger on impressive roll

All right, all right, already! I'll talk about Chris Greninger in my column this week! Greninger has been crazy good since the start of 2012, and punctuated his new-year run of big scores with a 300 game last Wednesday in the Washout League.

His 738 series was his fourth in five outings this year, including a 743, 746 and 719.

Even the one that he missed was a healthy 659.

If you're doing the math at home, that's a 240.3 average since Jan. 1.

Maybe most impressive is that out of 20 games this year, only one has been under 200 — and that was a 192 just before he threw the perfect game.

Seeing as I'm on his team, I can report that the 300 game was pretty solid.

There were a couple of light hits along the way to the 10th frame, but Greninger throws a powerful hook that sprayed the rack.

The first ball in the 10th was a solid Brooklyn and the 11th was dead perfect.

I was worried about the last one when it left his hand, because it was a bit outside and a little slow. But, although it went high, the seven pin slithered off the back of the deck and Greninger had his second career 300 game. His first came almost four years earlier to the day — Jan. 31, 2008.

Greninger's perfect game was the fifth in the Door County USBC this season, the last being thrown by Scott Voeks on Nov. 22.

Overall, it's the 85th in association history.

## Paschke joins county's elite 800 club

The big scores just keep rolling in, which makes my job quite a bit easier. When I have a superlative effort on the lanes to talk about, I don't have to scratch my head thinking up a topic for this column.

Helping me out this week was Jeff Paschke, a longtime bowler in the Wednesday Washout league at Apple Valley. Paschke rolled 800 on the head last week with



games of 253, 279 and 268. In the process, he became the 11th bowler in Door County history to notch a series of 800 or better.

Paschke is another of those bowlers who throw

the "deep inside" line that has led to a number of big scores this year. He'll be the first to admit that he's not as successful week in week out as Scott Voeks or Mike Cuculi, but when he's on — like he was this past outing — he puts up some excellent numbers.

One of them was 17: the number of strikes in a row he threw from the fourth frame of the second game to the eighth frame of the third. I did-

n't get a chance to talk to him about it, but he must have had some idea of what he needed for the 800, and a couple of nine counts in the ninth and tenth frames of that final game left him a strike away. As difficult as it is to finish off a perfect game, there may be even more pressure to carry a strike to get to 800.

To his credit, Paschke pulled it off. And, also to his credit, he threw an all-mark series — a rare enough feat in and of itself these days.

For those of you scoring along at home, it was 28 strikes, six spares and a seven count on a first-game fill ball. Everything fell perfectly into place for an 800 series.

Paschke's 800 was the 20th in Door County bowling history. Five of the 11 bowlers who have accomplished that feat did it before throwing a perfect game. Only Matt Heldmann has rolled a 300 (twice) since his 800.

And here's a statistic I found interesting

while researching this column: out of the 20 800 series now recorded in Door County, how many included a 300 game?

The answer? Only four — and all of them by Mike Cuculi.

# Cuculi back on top of his game

**M**ike Cuculi is picking up where he left off during the 2009-10 season.

After a year in which he didn't record a perfect game or an 800 series, he now has two of each — and shows no sign of slowing down.

Cuculi once again tore up the lanes at Apple Valley — this time in the Majors — with an 821 series on games of 279, 242 and 300. The 821 was a career high, his sixth 800, and agonizingly close to the 825 county record held by Scott Voeks.

A look at his frame-by-frame performance shows just how little room for error there is to reach the rarified atmosphere of an 800 series. Out of 35 first-balls thrown by Cuculi, 31 were strikes. He began his night with an open frame, then ran the next 11 in a row. The second game included a split in the fifth frame sandwiched by two "hambones" (four strikes in a row), and topped off by a seven count in the tenth, which he covered for his only spare of the night (with a nine count on the fill ball). The perfect game finished the evening.

Thirty-one strikes. One spare. Two opens.

I've had near-700 series where I lamented the rare open frame that cost me those precious pins. (Newsflash: I twice missed on 10-pin conversions in my first game

Sunday evening and shot 689). Little did Cuculi know when his evening began how crucial that initial error would be to missing out on the county record.

Cuculi now owns six of the 16 800-plus series shot in Door County bowling history, and 11 of the 83 perfect games.

After his first 300/800 of the season back in September, I commented on Cuculi's ability to concentrate from delivery to delivery in shooting his high scores. There may be another facet to the equation, however.

Cuculi, like fellow perfect gamer Geoff Hansen and the aforementioned record holder Voeks — among a few others — throw what is known as an "inside" line. That is, they start the ball over the third arrow from the right-hand side of the lane (or even farther toward the middle), "swing" it deep down the lane to the outside and then hook it back to the pocket.

Most bowlers with a hook throw the ball "down and in" over second arrow. This is an easier shot, requiring fewer ball revolu-

tions and a bit less accuracy, given the oil pattern on the lanes.

One possible advantage Cuculi and other inside players may have is that, because there is more oil in the center of the lane and fewer bowlers play that line, the shot doesn't change much — or not at all — during the course of a series. They still have some room for error, as their strike shots drive deep down the lane and find a relatively untouched area that other bowlers do not. This means that their balls will still be hooking hard long after the "down-and-in" bowlers have pushed the oil down the lane and deadened the back ends where the ball begins to grab the wood.

In other words, Cuculi throws his ball where most do not. This gives him more consistent reaction from the start of a series to the end.

As a "down-and-in" bowler, I try to get the same advantage by throwing between the first two arrows on the right side of the alley. However, there is less oil out there and others throwing second arrow will stray into my line on occasion. I often have a great start to the evening before my line changes — often before the end of the first game.

One way or another, Cuculi is well into what could

be a record season, averaging 240 in the Wednesday Night Washout and 232 in the Majors. It will be interesting to see how many more big scores he has in store.

And then there's Mike Cuculi. Shoots his third 800 series of the season same night Davis shoots his 300 — on the same team. Rolls 252-268-289 for 809. The ladies ain't impressed anymore with some little ol' 700, nosiree. Gotta get them eights.

So, that's the 23rd 800 series in Door County, eight of 'em by Cuculi. Plus Todd Cater and Jeff Paschke this season.



# Cuculi rolls into record book

**M**ike Cuculi's 813 series in the Apple Valley Washout league earlier this month was the 18th series of 800 or higher registered in the history of the Door County USBC Bowling Association. Cuculi now has five of them, including the fourth-, fifth- and sixth-highest.

The association is small compared to the Green Bay-Bay Area USBC Bowling Association, so 800 series are not nearly as prevalent. Latest figures showed only 434 bowlers in the association.

There are 18 sanctioned lanes in the association, six at the Sister Bay Bowl and 12 at Apple Valley Lanes in Sturgeon Bay. Cherry Lanes in Sturgeon Bay does not have any sanctioned lanes.

Cuculi, an electrician, is the son of Pat Cuculi, who is a member of the GBBA Hall of Fame, and co-owner of Apple Valley Lanes with daughter Michelle Pfannenstiel.

In his latest 800 series, Mike Cuculi started out with a 279 and after a 234 middle game, closed out with a 300, the 10th perfect game of his career, most in the history of the association which has a total of 81.

A 4-9 split in the eighth frame of his second game kept Cuculi from getting a shot at the association's top score, an 825 bowled by Scott Voeks on Dec. 17, 2010. Voeks is second to Cuculi with four 800s as the two have combined for half of the 18 top series.

The 42-year-old Cuculi grew up in Green Bay and competed in the Green Bay Junior Bowling Association programs, first at Golden Bowl, then at Willow Creek Lanes.

"I think I was about 8 when I started bowling

at Golden Bowl and when I was 10 or 11, I moved to the program at Willow Creek.

"Dad used to coach at Willow Creek so we got all the free bowling we wanted and I practiced a lot," Cuculi said. "Dad helped me a lot with my game and there always were a lot of other guys like Dick Diener, Dick Buchholz and Alex Pogorzelski (all members of the GBBA, Hall of Fame) around and they helped me, too."

When Cuculi was 16, his dad bought Apple Valley Lanes and they moved to Door County.

"After that I didn't practice much, not as much as I would have liked to. I was busy helping at the lanes," Mike said.

As for falling short of topping Voeks' score, Cuculi said, "Somebody will break it some day, probably yet this year. Hopefully I will get another chance, but you never know."

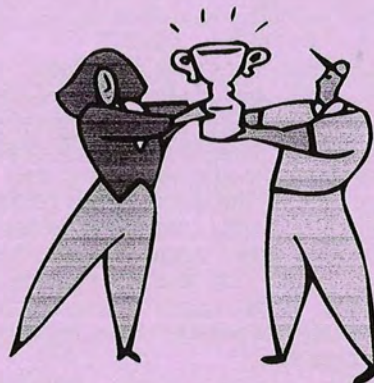
