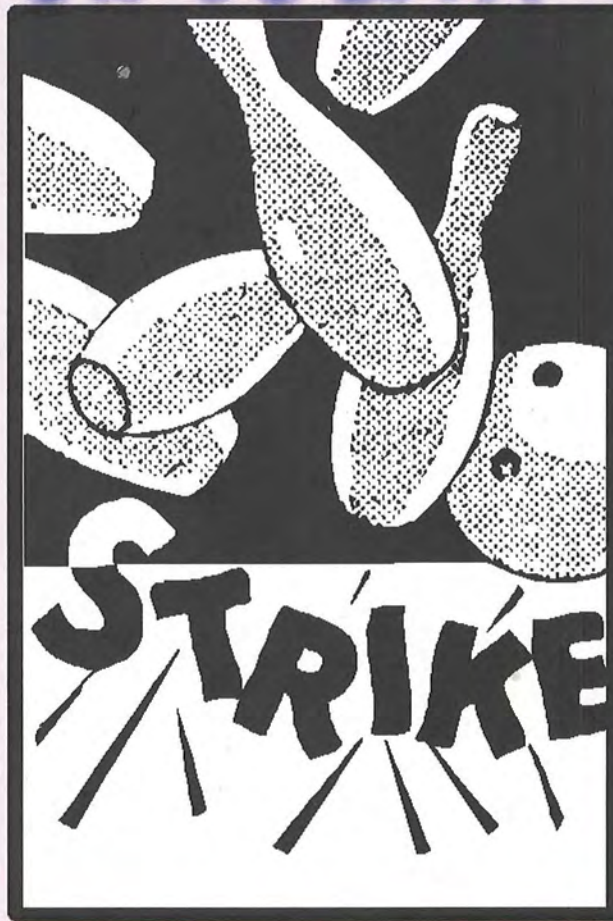

## DOOR COUNTY USBC ANNUAL DELEGATES MEETING

April 14, 2008 Apple Valley Lanes

President *Barnie Haen* called the meeting to order at 7:15 p.m.

Roll call showed *Dave Wanke, May Jutila, Linda Jarman, Michelle Pfannenstiel, Pat Cuculi, Steph Hartel* and *Tim Jutila* present.

*Eddy Allen* was absent.

*Jim Regner* of the *Sturgeon Bay Industrial League* was present. Board members represented the following leagues: *Apple Valley Classic, Apple Dumpling, Apple Valley Majors, Northernettes, Thursday Nite Cut-Ups, Wednesday Night Washout* and the *Women's Apple Corps*.

The following leagues were not represented: *Early Sunday Mixed, Odd Couples, Sister Bay Tavern* and the *Women's Masters*.

Secretary's report of *April 23, 2007* was presented in written form. Motion to accept as written by *Jim Regner*, seconded by *Linda Jarman*, passed.

Financial report for the Association including reports for the *Hall of Fame Banquet* and the *County Tournament* were presented in written form. Motion to accept by *Pat Cuculi*, seconded by *May Jutila*, passed.

### Committee Reports:

*Finance* (*Barnie\**, *Pat, Eddy*): Finances were reviewed at the beginning of the season and were in order. Everything will again be checked at the summer meeting.

*Youth* (*Michelle*): We have 60 sanctioned juniors that bowl here in Door County, but they are sanctioned through the *Green Bay Association* so they can take advantage of tournaments. We had 3 teams that went to State in *March* in *Oconomowoc*. Three (3) girls qualified for the 500 Tournament and 1 boy qualified for the 600 Tournament, both of which will be held in *Wausau* in *July*. *Adam LaLuzerne* bowled a 692 and is currently 3<sup>rd</sup> in the *Singles* event and *Adam and Sam Oakley* are currently in 1<sup>st</sup> in the *Doubles* event. We sent 19 juniors to the *High Average Tournament* in *Green Bay* where they competed against over 136 other bowlers, and while they bowled well, did not place. *Apple Valley* also recently held an *Adult/Youth* tournament and had 42 teams. They will again be offering *Adult/Youth* summer leagues on *Wednesday* and *Friday* with winners earning a *Wisconsin Dells* package that includes competing in the *Adult/Youth State Bowling* tournament. Last year *Robert Peterson* and *Rachel Hale* from *Apple Valley Lanes* took 1<sup>st</sup> Place.

*Barnie* brought up the possibility of financially helping the youth bowlers and their families by funding or partially funding gas money and/or tournament expenses so that more youth can compete in tournaments. Because of such tight restrictions on anything monetary that youth can receive,



Michelle will inquire what can be done about this when she attends the Youth Board Meeting in Green Bay in June.

*Hall of Fame* (Kathy\*, Pat, Barnie, Michelle, Linda Jarman): We held our 2<sup>nd</sup> Hall of Fame banquet on 10/20/07 and had 88 people attend. Sue Sperber and Tim Jutila were inducted in the Hall of Fame, both for Superior Performance. Scott Voeks was recognized for his 804 series and Lisa Hartel (708), Steph Hartel (705 & 701) and Sue Sperber (726) for their 700 series. Men's 800 series, Women's 700 series and 300 games are given once only awards. We awarded 7 one-time 300 awards, 4 from the previous season. Paige Nelson and Jeffrey Hirsch were our Junior Bowlers of the Year. County Tournament winners and Association High Game, Series and Average winners were also honored. Special guests Joe Boulanger from the Men's State Association and Pat Dederich from the Women's State Association were in attendance. Our banquet for this year is tentatively set for Saturday, October 18, 2008. We are currently looking for applicants for induction this year.

*Tournament* (Dave\*, Steph, Eddy): Final standing sheet and prize list were distributed. Entries in all the events were down this year. We will be looking into different formats and times for next year. Because of low entries this year, we gave the winning bowlers the choice of shirts or plaques. Women had a 2<sup>nd</sup> place in the Doubles event, the highest finish for an all-woman team. Women also took 5<sup>th</sup> place and 10<sup>th</sup> place in the singles event. We would have a 2<sup>nd</sup> place all-events woman if she had gotten in. Our all-woman team took 6<sup>th</sup> place, just short of cashing. We will continue working on getting more bowlers involved. The Association added \$1 per member (\$473) and raised \$574 in 50/50 raffle money for the prize fund.

*Nominating* (May\*, Tim, Dave): Directors Pat Cuculi, Steph Hartel and Tim Jutila were up for re-election. Steph Hartel decided to resign from the Board. Motion to re-elect Pat Cuculi and Tim Jutila by Dave Wanke, seconded by May Jutila, passed. Motion to elect Jim Regner to Director by Tim Jutila, seconded by May Jutila, passed. Congratulations, Jim!

Delegates reports from Barnie Haen (Men's State), Linda Jarman (Women's State) and Kathy Franke (USBC Summit) were discussed and presented in written form. They are attached.

***The next Board of Director's Meeting will be Monday, August 18, 2008 at 7 p.m. at Apple Valley Lanes.***

Meeting adjourned at 8:16 p.m. Motion to adjourn by Linda Jarman, seconded by Jim Regner, passed.

Work can be fun! It was a busy weekend with the main meeting, 500 club, bowling writers (worked on ways & means, photography, poster, and writing contests), and JKS scholarship. As always, I supported all of the organizations by purchasing lots of raffle tickets.

Four officers, nine directors, and 204 delegates attended the main meeting to witness the induction of Hall of Fame members Sally Barwick and Mary Hansen for Meritorious Service, and Diane Stanislawski for Superior Performance. Diane has bowled six 300 games, despite having osteoarthritis and enduring two hip repairs and painful rehab. (I complain when I have to take Aleve to bowl.)

The state association currently has 43,689 members. We are also tops in tournament participation, once again edging out Michigan. Hope more women will participate when we bowl in Milwaukee next year. We can't rest on our laurels.

Six one thousand dollar scholarships were awarded to youth bowlers. If anyone knows of a graduating senior who would like to apply, please contact me or Pat Tebon at the main office 1-800-660-9655. It's not a long and complicated process like some scholarships.

## Joe Bowler gets state festivities rolling

This past weekend, I served as the Door County representative to the Wisconsin United States Bowling Congress annual meeting, hall of fame banquet and opening ceremony of the 2008 state bowling tournament.

I arrived at the Super Bowl on the northeast side of Appleton just in time for the tournament festivities. The state directors sit on chairs on the lane approaches while state association representatives and local dignitaries, including the mayor, the local association manager and the proprietors of both host centers, say a few words.

Then comes the highlight: The opening ball of the tournament rolled by the person on the first shift chosen at random to be "Joe Bowler." You may think that this is quite an honor, but there's a catch. The chosen kegler must wear a crown and a heavy cape while doing so.

This year's Joe Bowler was Roger Tonyan Sr. of Rice Lake, the No. 4 man on the Wonder Lake Auto Body team. Roger did pretty well, going a bit heavy in the pocket and leaving the 3-10 split. Supposedly, the reward is a silver dollar per

pin, but Tonyan was given the full complement of 10 despite his less-than-perfect ball.

If you'd like your shot at being Joe Bowler next year, I think you'd have a pretty good chance of getting on the first shift. There were only 21 teams in the 48-lane Super Bowl Saturday morning. Dave Dombrowski of Sturgeon Bay was chosen Joe Bowler one year at state, and I can't remember what the outcome of his official opening roll was, because I wasn't there. I believe he acquitted himself well, however.

After lunch, it was off to the Paper Valley Hotel for the annual state USBC delegates meeting. Originally scheduled for 3:30 p.m., it was moved up an hour because of some football game or something.

Reports were delivered by the state USBC president, Joe Boulanger of Green Bay, as

well as the chairmen of The tournament, scholarship, hall of fame, events, legislative, financial and nominating committees. The legislative committee report blossomed into an interesting look at what the USBC heard from association representatives during an open listening session this past fall. Recommendations were made for what state and local associations — as well as the national office — could do more of ... and less of ... in the eyes of the average bowler.

There was also a good discussion about the situation with high school bowling programs; how the WIAA and local school district athletic directors feel about them; and how to go about getting approval to start them up. This has been a difficulty in Door County for a few years now, as attempts to create high school programs here have, as yet, not been successful. Statewide, 138 districts fielded 441 teams with more than 2,500 participants this past school year, which seems to indicate that good progress is being made elsewhere in Wisconsin.

An extensive financial report by state association manager Phil LaPorte seemed to indi-

cate that the state tournament is in good shape. Numbers continue to be strong for both the regular and senior tournaments, and both generate a profit that allows the state USBC to be run without an add on to Wisconsin sanction fees.

Saturday evening, the USBC inducted two very talented bowlers into the state hall of fame.

Ben Hoefs, currently the head coach of the West Bend East High School bowling team, was the 1984 state all-events champion and his 1995 team set a tournament record with a scratch score of 3,636.

Don Bartz won both the Peterson Classic in 1959 and the first "Bowling With The Champs" TV show. His teams won three state championships and his George Webb team rolled the high series in the entire United States three consecutive seasons from 1962 to 1964.

Next year the tournament will stay nearby in Green Bay, so consider getting your team involved.

## USBC Summit

September 28-30, 2007

Milwaukee, WI

The USBC incorporates over 3200 associations.

128 Local Association attendees representing 84 Local Associations  
84 State Association attendees representing 47 State Associations

Many associations had business cards, association shirts and/or name badges, websites.

We sat in round table discussions of about 10-12 per table.

The goal of the Summit was to "Grow the Sport".

Saturday morning's session concentrated on what State Associations should spend more time doing and less time doing.

More time doing:

1. better communication with local associations (e-mail/website/newsletter/grant program for local membership development/networking)
2. find out why we have lost bowlers
3. promote junior bowling at local and high school levels
4. education and marketing
5. senior programs
6. hold local summits - become state facilitators
7. be more proactive and visionary for local associations
8. improve image of bowling - less smoking & drinking
9. coaching pool/clinic to train coaches - both adults and juniors

Less time doing:

1. duplication of awards
2. USBC paperwork requirements
3. hoarding money (spend to promote sport)



4. everyone should merge/stop debating negatives of merging/quite referring to the past and to gender and become 1 organization
5. too many committees
6. duplication of data and not knowing who has paid state dues (USBC does not mark state dues on membership card)

Saturday afternoon's session concentrated on what Local Associations should spend more time doing and less time doing.

More time doing:

1. introduce/promote bowling to public/scholarship opportunities/youth leadership development skills
2. adult and youth coaching
3. better relationships with proprietors
4. streamline awards program
5. train board members as to their responsibilities
6. mentoring program: youth sit in on board meetings/youth help at tourneys/workshops for new league officers
7. support local charities: will give more visibility to bowling

Less time doing:

1. stop resisting change
2. delegate work - stop overworking good workers
3. stop being complacent and secretive
4. awards should not be left until end of season
5. no fundraising during league
6. don't give so many awards to high average bowlers
7. stop using outside ambassadors - use bowling ambassadors

Sunday's session concentrated on answering questions from the attendees. Once again, a lot of emphasis was put on the youth program.

Taxes was an issue brought up. Association Managers who make more than \$100 are required to file taxes and must be issued a W-2. Managers are considered employees per IRS rules because of bank deposits and making financial reports. These are State and National laws.



The importance of the Registered Volunteer Program was stressed.

We were shown a film clip of the new wave in bowling—2-handed bowling! The top amateur bowler in the world throws the ball with 2 hands and throws 22-23 mph and has a 30 mph spare ball! Currently there is no coaching for this.

I felt the Summit was very good as well as interesting. However, although many suggestions were given, nothing was discussed as to how to implement any changes or new programs. What concerned me was the emphasis on so many new programs to promote the sport and increase coaching at the local and state levels, but not how to get enough unpaid people to put in the time to get this all off the ground. I also feel that while youth bowling is important, time should also be spent promoting adult bowling and finding ways to keep regular bowlers bowling.

# Banquet to honor hall of fame inductees

The second annual Door County Bowling Hall of Fame awards banquet will be held Saturday night at the Reef Sports Bar in Sturgeon Bay.

This year's inductees are two local talents who have proven their expertise over a number of seasons and who have also been intimately involved with the promotion and management of the sport of bowling in Door County.

## Inductee Tim Jutila

In his 27 years as a sanctioned Door County bowler, Tim Jutila has almost always competed in several leagues each season. Other than Dave Wanke, who was inducted into the Hall of Fame last year, no one else has consistently rolled more than 300 league games per season.

Jutila was a regular at Worley's Lanes before it closed, bowled in the Cherry Lanes Commercial League for many years, and now participates in the Apple Valley Classic, Apple Valley Major and Apple Dumplings

leagues.

Jutila has a career-high series of 767 and carried a high average of 209 during the 1998-99 season. He has rolled 700 or better more than 20 times to this point in his career.

Jutila won the Door County Bowling Association doubles title in 2003, all-events in 1998 and singles event last season, when he was also runner-up in all events. He was the lead qualifier for the Door County Cup (the tournament scratch option) in 1998, and second in 2007. Over

the history of the Cup, Jutila has competed in the stepladder finals on numerous occasions.

In addition to his performance on the lanes, Jutila has been closely involved with running local bowling associations for many years.

He has been on the board of directors - first with the men's association, now with the combined association - since I have known him.

It was my pleasure to bowl with him for a decade on the Nightengale team in the Apple Valley Majors, and he remains a great friend and is an excellent source of bowling knowledge and advice.

### Inductee Sue Sperber

It can easily be argued that no Door County woman performed at a higher level over an extended time period than Sue Sperber.

After establishing a new Door County Women's Bowling Association (DCWBA) high average of 198 in 1987-88, she became the first Door County

woman bowler to carry a league average of 200 or better over an entire season (202 in 1998-99). Sperber held a high average of 192 or better for 14 consecutive seasons (1987-88 to 2003-04), leading the association in several of those years.

Sperber was also the first DCWBA member to throw a 700 series (708 during the 1985-86 season). Her high career series to date is a 729, and her best game a 289. She won the 1993 D C W B A Tournament doubles title with Sandy Mueller and finished second in the 1999 tournament with her team, Sperber Trucking.

She competed in the prestigious Queens Tournament four times, reaching the second round once. At Nationals in Reno, Nev., she scored better than 600 in all three of her series (team,

doubles and singles).

Although she would be the first to dismiss its significance, Sperber was the first woman to bowl in a Door County "men's" league - the Apple Valley Majors - after women were first allowed to join the American Bowling Congress.

Sperber often came out to watch her husband, Scott, bowl. I seem to remember that one night the Davis Mortuary team was short a man, and they coaxed Sue into joining them and paid her ABC sanction fee. After that, she was a sought-after sub who more than held her own against the guys, eventually becoming a league regular a few seasons ago.

In addition to her prowess on the lanes, Sperber was also active in the management of the women's association, serving on the Lane Certification and Inspection, Banquet, Tournament, Survey and 600 Club committees. She was an association director during the 1988-89 sea-

son and vice president in 1992-93. She was also the longtime secretary of two daytime women's leagues at Apple Valley Lanes.

### Other awards

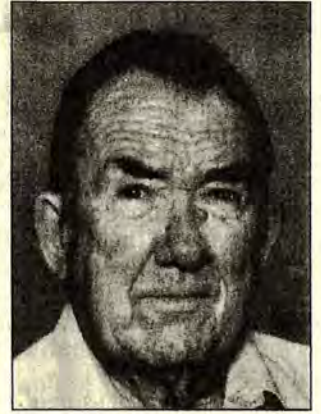
Earl K. Willems passed away peacefully at his Fort Lauderdale, Fla., home on April 23, 2008.

# Voeks wins Door County Cup crown

It's sort of fitting that Scott Voeks took home the Door County Cup Championship at Apple Valley Lanes Sunday.

Not only was he the leader heading into the finals, but the win caps an impressive run of high scores over the past couple of weeks.

Let's start with a recap of the Cup, which is a scratch option in the Door County U.S. Bowling Congress tournament. Bowlers use their first scores from each tournament location - Apple Valley Lanes and the Sister Bay Bowl - and then roll three more qualifying games across three pairs of lanes at the championship site, which this year happened to be Apple Valley.

In the qualifying round, two bowlers stood out (and took almost all of the pot money). Leif Mickelson blasted a 758 series on games of 230, 290 and 248 to move into second place and Torry Lake jumped from eighth to fourth on the strength of a 726 series with games of 256, 279 and 191.

Quite a ways back were Jason Daubner with a 621 and Voeks, who managed to maintain his top qualifying spot despite a relatively pedestrian 601 series.

The stepladder finals began with fifth-place qualifier Doc Bundy facing the scorching-hot Lake, who pumped out a 247 over Bundy's 191 to take game one. I took advantage

of the short break between games to run home and get my digital camera for a shot of the eventual winner. When I returned, game three was already under way.

Why? Third-place qualifier Daubner ran the first 10 strikes in game two against Lake, and defeated him 289-219. A whole lot of strikes don't take a whole lot of time.

Daubner then matched up against Mickelson, author of the 758 series earlier in the afternoon. After leaving the 3-6-7-10 split in the first frame and failing to pick it

up, Daubner proceeded to run them out for 11 strikes in a row and a 279, easily besting Mickelson's 184.

Going into the title match against Voeks, Daubner had thrown 21 of his last 23 balls for strikes. But neither bowler was able to string anything in a closely fought match. Voeks offered an opening by missing a 10-pin in the sixth frame, but Dauber returned the favor by leaving the bucket in the seventh and failing to cover it. After a double by Voeks in the seventh and eighth, a stone eight-pin on lane 11 by

Daubner (his second of the game) sealed his fate.

Final score: Voeks 200, Daubner 177.

The victory by Voeks allows me to kill two turkeys with one bowling ball, so to speak.

The **Barnie Haen** 300-game jinx was broken by none other than Voeks in the Apple Valley Majors Feb. 19, as he authored the sixth perfect game in our association this season, No. 58 all time and the fifth of his career - four of which he's rolled here in Door County. By doing so, he became the first bowler to repeat the feat in 2007-2008, as the previous five were all first-timers.

Although Voeks only totaled a 691 on the night of his latest 300 game, he's put up some impressive numbers lately. He rode his 786 in the team event of the tournament Feb. 24 to the top qualifying spot in the Cup, and came back the week after the perfect to shoot 789 in the Majors. In between, he threw in a teeny weeny little 760 (279 game) while subbing in the Thursday Cut-Ups Feb. 21.

Not a bad week. From Tuesday, Feb. 19 to Tuesday, Feb. 26: 12 games, 3,026 pins and an average of 252. Almost Green Bay numbers.

Let's just say that the ball he used that evening had not been well-loved. It originally belonged to Mike Cuculi, who sold it to John Moore, who sold it to Hoelzel. Who threw it a few times two seasons ago and then moved on to a new ball.

And he was forced to wear rental shoes, prob-

Add that all up, and you'd think that he should have just stayed home. Sounds like a recipe for a terrible night of bowling.

But sometimes adversity helps. The story of the keys kept his mind off his game. The sprained knee forced him to be fundamentally sound and deliberate with his approach. Because his approach was slower, he threw the ball harder, which translated into more lift and more hook.

Still, three more strikes and a nine count would earn him Door County's fifth 800 series, and that's what he ended up with.

If luck evens out, then Hoelzel certainly had some coming that night at the lanes. Congratulations.

Congratulations also go to Nikki LaViolette, who rolled her first-ever 200 game (also right on the head) in the Apple Dumplings. Jeff Plaszkiwicz had the high game of 247 and a big 679

series, losing out only to Scott Voeks and a 699. May Jutila led the ladies with 626 (228), and Sheryl Ripp had a 233 game.

Trailing Hoelzel in the Majors were Bill LeMieux 739 (278) and Andy LaLuzerne 711.
