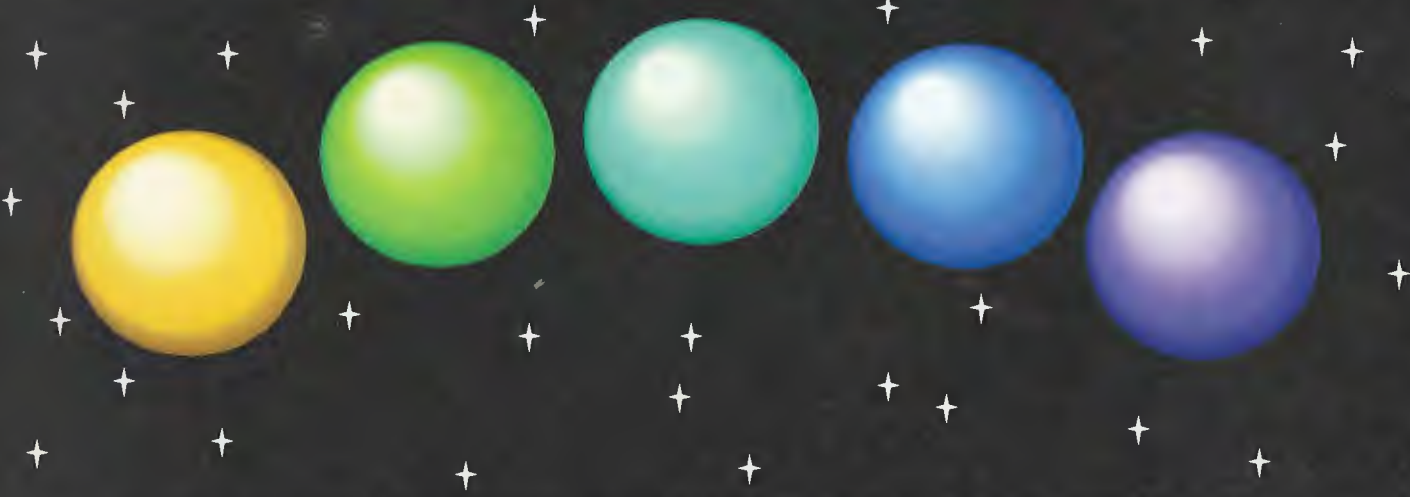
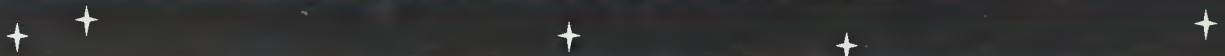

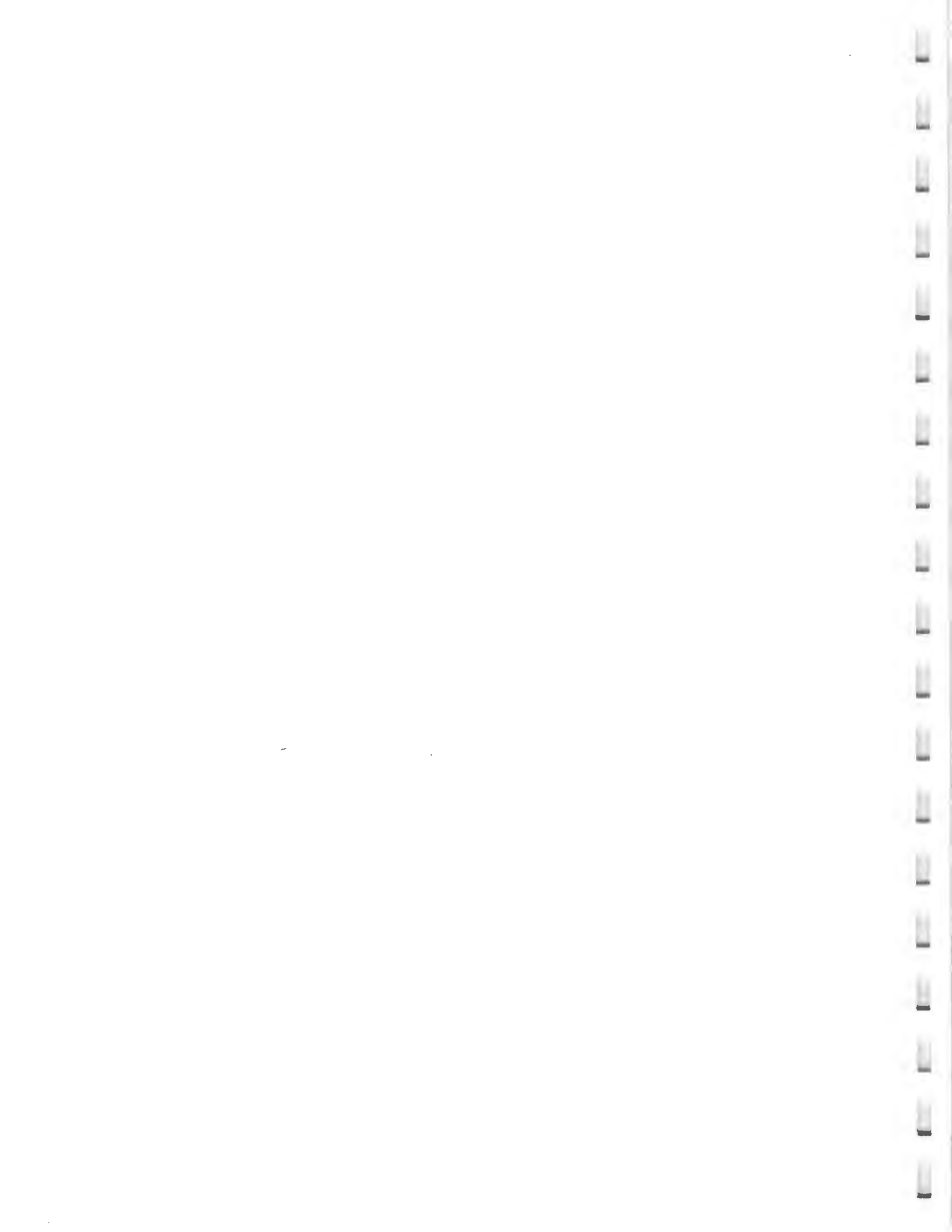

DOOR COUNTY USBC ASSOCIATION BYLAWS

Article I Name

The name of the organization is the Door County USBC Association, chartered by the United States Bowling Congress (USBC).

The Door County USBC Association is an adult merged association in a non-merged State (WI).

Door County youth bowlers are not merged with the Door County USBC, but are merged in the Green Bay Youth Bowling Association. Youth bylaws will be added and adopted should the Door County youth merge with the Door County USBC.

Article II Nonprofit Corporation and Charter

Section A. Nonprofit Corporation

The Association is organized as a nonprofit corporation and operates consistent with the requirements of an organization classified as tax exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (IRC).

Section B. Charter

The Association shall be chartered by USBC and subject to its authority. To maintain its charter, the association must:

1. Provide services for men and women.
2. Adopt bylaws approved by USBC.
3. Not enact any bylaws or rules inconsistent with *USBC Bylaws*.
4. Adhere to stated requirements as set forth in the *USBC Bylaws* and *USBC Association Policy Manual*.

Section C. Association Dissolution

Upon dissolution of this organization all of its assets remaining after payment of its lawful obligations shall be distributed in accordance with the requirements of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and regulations promulgated thereunder.

Article III

Purpose

The purposes of the association as stated in the Articles of Incorporation, include, but are not limited to:

1. Providing equal opportunity for all in the sport of bowling without regard to race, religion, age, gender, disability, or national origin.
2. Promoting the game of American Tenpins.
3. Conducting and supporting bowling competition.
4. Engaging in any other activities permitted by an organization classified as tax exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the IRC.

Article IV

Membership and Dues

Membership is in effect from August 1 through July 31 and is composed of:

1. Adults who have paid the appropriate USBC, state and local association dues.

Each individual shall pay annual USBC membership dues, local dues (adult) or local processing fee and State Association dues, except as provided in Rule 100e, Traveling League and 100l, Mail-o-Graphic League.

The adult members, and all officers and directors, by two-thirds vote, determine and adopt local dues, if any.

The annual adult standard membership dues are as follows:

Senior Men/Women (age 65 as of August 1)

State	\$ 0.00 (Cannot exceed \$1)*
USBC adult standard membership	<u>\$10.00</u>
Total	\$12.00

*\$1 WI State dues for women choosing to be State members is paid by the Door County USBC Association.

The Board may waive all or part of local adult dues for:

1. Members of other USBC associations having a reciprocal agreement with the association.
2. Other groups, such as seniors, etc., as determined the Board.

The association cannot charge additional non-dues assessments.

Article V
Board of Directors - Management

Section A. Board Composition, Authority and Duties

The management and governance of the association is vested in the Board of Directors that includes the Officer and Director positions. The members determine the number of positions on the Board of Directors and their term. The total number of board members is 10, with 8 total number of directors. Of the 8 directors, 1 shall be a youth director.

Should the Door County youth merge with the Door County USBC, at least 20% of the total number of Board members will be elected by the Youth Representatives and officers and directors who hold youth membership. The number of Board members elected by the Youth Representatives and officers and directors who hold youth membership will be 2 (one boy and one girl).

The Board shall not engage in any acts constituting a conflict of interest. The Board's duties include but are not limited to:

1. Enforcing the bylaws.
2. Complying with the *USBC Association Policy Manual*.

3. Conducting championship level competition for its membership constituency (men, women) and complying with state and local laws in their area.
4. Implementing USBC programs as requested.
5. Selecting/appointing the Association Manager.
6. Approving use of membership records.
7. Re-rating the league average of an association member when there is evidence the bowler's average does not represent the bowler's true ability.
8. Conducting suspension and reinstatement hearings if requested by USBC Headquarters.

Section B. Eligibility

A candidate for the Board (elected or appointed) must be:

1. A USBC member in good standing of the association at the time of election and throughout their term.
2. Elected or appointed without regard to race, color, religion, gender, disability, national origin, or age, other than the minimum age of 14, unless state laws mandate a specific age, and be reasonably representative of the membership.
 - a. Any member of the Board authorized to sign contracts or acting as a signatory on association accounts must be a minimum age of 18.
 - b. A maximum of three bowling center proprietors may serve on the Board at one time. A proprietor is an individual who is the owner, partner, or corporate officer of a bowling center or group of bowling centers. Excluded from the definition of proprietor is an individual who owns 25% or less of the equity shares, or who is inactive in the management of the bowling center and remains so during a term as an officer or director.

Additional eligibility requirements, if any, are to be approved by the members.

Section C. Election of Officers

Directors are elected by majority, unless plurality vote is adopted, by the members. Directors whose positions are subject to election by the adult members are elected by majority vote of adult members, and all officers and directors, present and voting from:

1. A slate.
2. Nominations from the floor.

Qualifications must be submitted in a format specified by the Board.

Voting will be by ballot if there is more than one nominee for each position.

Section D. Term

The term for directors is 3 years. The members determine the number of years in a term and the number of terms allowed. For two- and three-year terms the members establish a stagger system.

Year 1: President, 3 Directors

Year 2: Vice President, 3 Directors

Year 3: President, 2 Directors

Section E. Resignation, Removal, and Vacancies

1. **Resignation.** A Board member may resign from the Board of Directors by providing written notice of resignation to the president or, in the case of the president, to the Board.
2. **Removal for Ineligibility.** A Board member who is no longer eligible to serve on the Board may be removed by a two-thirds vote of the Board when a quorum is present.
3. **Removal for Cause.** When a Board member is accused, in writing, of failure to properly perform the duties of their office or otherwise engaging in improper or unfair activities or conduct, the Board may conduct a meeting following the Removal Procedures in the Suspension and Reinstatement Chapter. An appeal may be filed with USBC Headquarters within 15 days of the removal. Two-thirds written consent of the full Board is required to seek re-election and/or re-appointment to the Board.
4. **Vacancies.** Vacancies in positions on the Board are filled for the un-expired portion of each term as follows:
 - a. If elected by the members, director vacancies are filled by the president, subject to approval by the Board.
 - b. The Board fills vacancies in officer positions.

Article VI Officers

Section A. President and Vice President

The officers of this association shall include a president and vice president.

Section B. Election

The members determine the election process.

1. Officers are elected by a majority vote of the adult members, officers and directors, present and voting from:
 - a. A slate.
 - b. Nominations from the floor.

Qualifications must be submitted in a format specified by the Board.

Voting will be by ballot if there is more than one nominee for each position.

Section C. Term

The term for elected officers is 2 years. By USBC mandate, terms may exceed three years. There is no limit to the number of terms allowed.

Section D. Authority and Duties

1. President

- a. Presides at all meetings.
- b. Acts as spokesperson for the association.
- c. Appoints committees with Board approval.

2. Vice President

- a. Presides at all meetings when the president is absent.
- b. Performs other duties as prescribed by the Board or requested by the president.

3. Association Manager

- a. Selected/appointed by and accountable to the Board
- b. Acts as the ex officio non-voting secretary/treasurer of the Board or such other officer designation as required by law and determined by the Board.
- c. Responsible for other duties as prescribed by the Board and in the *USBC Association Policy Manual*.

Article VII

Meetings

Section A. Annual Meeting

An Annual Meeting of association members shall be held at a time and place approved by the Board of Directors.

1. Attendance

Attendance is open to all members.

Voice and Vote

Voting officers, directors, and adult members. Members not meeting the above criteria may attend with voice only. Absentee and proxy voting are not permitted.

2. Responsibilities

- a. All adult members, officers and directors shall elect delegates and alternates for the USBC Annual Meeting.
- b. Adult members and all officers and directors shall:
 1. Adopt bylaws.
 2. Adopt local adult dues, up to the established maximum
 3. Elect up to 80% of the total number of Board members.
 4. Elect delegates and alternates representing adult membership for the state annual meetings.

5. Meeting Notice

Written notice of the meeting shall be forwarded to the league secretaries at least 15 days prior to the annual meeting.

6. Special Meetings

Special membership meetings may be called by the president or upon written request of at least three (3) Board members or at least twenty-five (25) members of the Association.

7. Quorum

- a. 6 Members constitute a quorum. The members determine the number.

8. Action

A majority vote of those members present and voting, at properly noticed meeting, when a quorum has been established, is required to take action, unless otherwise provided by law or these bylaws. Election of officers requires a majority vote. Election of directors requires a majority vote, unless plurality vote has been adopted in accordance with the bylaws. Election of delegates and alternates requires a plurality vote. Absentee and proxy voting are not permitted.

Section B. Board Meeting

The Board shall meet, at a minimum, as often as required by state law. Special meetings may be held upon request of any Board member if a majority of the Board approves.

1. **Notice.** Written notice for all regular and special meetings shall be forwarded to the Board, which should be at least 15 days prior to the meeting.
2. **Quorum.** 6 Board members constitute a quorum. The members determine the number.
3. **Action.** A majority vote of those officers and directors present and voting, at a properly noticed meeting, when a quorum has been established, is required to take action, unless otherwise provided by law or these bylaws. Absentee and proxy voting are not permitted.
4. **Action(s) Without a Meeting.** Actions that are deemed necessary to conduct business/operations of the Association may be taken outside of a Board meeting by use of mail, e-mail or teleconferencing. This type of action must be permissible by State law and approved by the membership/Youth Representatives and the Board.
The Association does allow the Board to vote via mail, e-mail, or teleconference.

Section C. Parliamentary Procedure

The most recent of *Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised*, governs all meetings.

Article VIII Committees

Section A. Standing Committees

The Association shall have the following Standing Committee: Finance.

1. **Finance Committee.** The committee is responsible for reviewing and monitoring Association financial matters.

Section B. Other Committees

The President may establish other committees, with Board approval.

Article IX

Delegates, Youth Delegates and Alternates

Section A. USBC Annual Meeting

Delegates and alternates are elected by plurality vote of those adult members and officers and directors, present and voting. (Note: A delegate must be 18 years or older and holds a USBC membership.)

Section B. State Annual Meeting

1. Delegates and alternates representing adults are elected by plurality vote of those adult members present and voting.

Section C. Eligibility

1. **USBC Annual Meeting.** Delegates and Alternates must be:
 - a. Elected by the Board, adult members and Youth Representatives.
 - b. At least 18 years of age.
 - c. A USBC member in good standing of the Association at the time of election and throughout their term.
2. **State Annual Meetings.** Delegates and Alternates must be:
 - a. Elected by adult members.
 - b. At least 18 years of age.
 - c. A USBC member in good standing of the Association at the time of election and throughout their term.

If a member is elected to represent more than one association to attend the same meeting, the first election shall stand and any succeeding election shall be declared null and void.

A local association is not eligible to send delegates if it is declared delinquent or USBC has revoked its charter. (Note: An association that has not processed dues for the current season shall be considered delinquent.)

Section D. Election

Delegates and alternates serve for one year, beginning August 1, and are elected by:

1. A slate.

2. Nominations from the floor (qualifications must be submitted in a format specified by the Board).
3. Plurality vote. The election shall be by ballot, except that a voice vote may be taken when the number of candidates does not exceed the number of positions to be filled.
4. Alternates shall serve in order of their election.

The election is to be held in compliance with the USBC or State Annual Meeting requirements.

Section E. Vacancies

Vacancies are filled for the un-expired portion of each term as follows:

1. If elected by adult members, vacancies are filled by the alternates in the order in which they were elected. If a vacancy still exists, the President fills the vacant position by appointment.

The appointee must also meet the same eligibility requirements as elected positions.

Article X Amendments

Section A. Procedure

Any member of the Association may submit proposed amendments to these bylaws. The local association bylaws may be amended at any membership meeting by a two-thirds vote of the members present and voting. The amendment must be:

1. Submitted in writing to the Association Manager or President.
2. Submitted at least 30 days prior to the membership meeting when the Association is considering the proposal.

Section B. Change in Adult Dues

Forward a notice to each league secretary and the Board at least 15 days prior to the meeting at which the proposed change is considered. The notice must:

1. Be in writing.
2. Specify the amount of the change.
3. Specify the reason for the change.

Notification of any adopted change in adult dues, and the reason for the change, will be forwarded, in writing, to each league secretary.

Section C. Effective Date

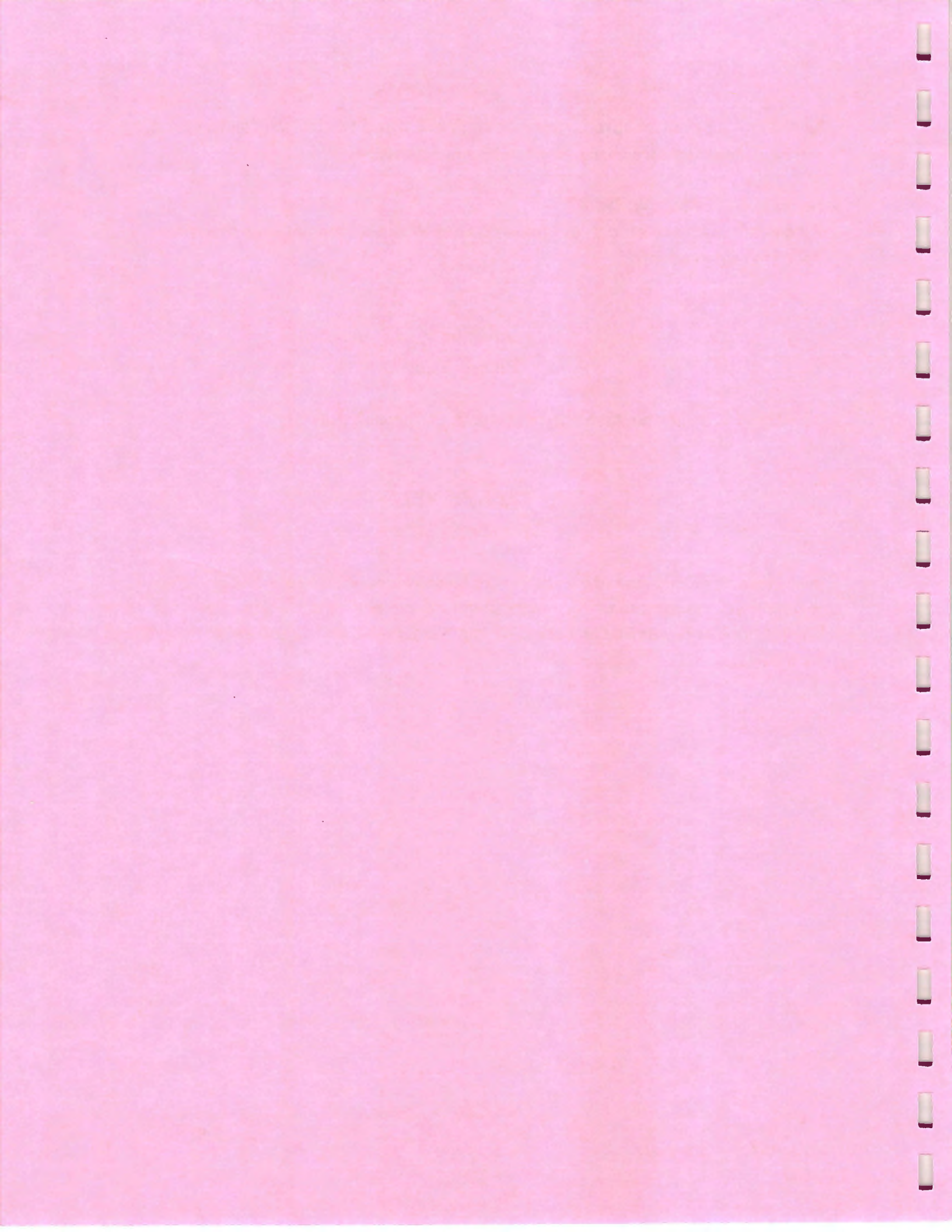
All amendments are effective August 1, following adoption, unless otherwise specified when adopted.

Fiscal Year**

The fiscal year of the Association is August 1 through July 31.

**Article XII
Indemnification**

Directors, officers, and other authorized volunteers, employees or agents shall be indemnified against claims for personal individual liability arising in connection with their positions or service on behalf of the Association to the full extent permitted by law.

DOOR COUNTY USBC ANNUAL DELEGATES MEETING

August 7, 2013 Apple Valley Lanes

President **Barnie Haen** called the meeting to order at 7:35 p.m.

Roll call showed **Jim Regner, Michelle Pfannenstiel** and **Todd Jacobs** present.

Rose Polcen, Tracy VanLanen, Brandon Kinjerski and **Mike Daubner** were absent.

League Delegates present were: **David Franke** of the **Apple Dumplings**, **Jeff Isaksen** of **Apple Valley Majors**, **Todd Jacobs** of the **Wednesday Washouts & the Early Sunday Mixed**, **Joan Franda** of the **Women's Masters**, **Momzi Jutila** of the **Apple Valley Classic**, and **Joy Bordeau** of the **Women's Apple Corp.**

The following leagues were not represented: **Northernettes, Odd Couples, Sister Bay Tavern** and **Sunday Adult/Youth.**

Secretary's report of **April 16, 2012** was presented in written form and summarized. No changes or additions were suggested.

Financial Report, including HOF and Tournament financial statements, and Membership information were presented in written form. The financial report showed all deposits and expenses for sanctions, Hall of Fame Banquet and the County Tournament. Detailed financial reports from the Hall of Fame and the County Tournament were also distributed. Due to running 50/50 raffles to help cover expenses, the HOF banquet is \$125 over. The Tournament account is over and will be added to the prize fund next year. The membership chart shows a decrease in sanctions of about 36, which has resulted in a decrease in revenue of \$216. With the leagues paying for their own BLS updates and the extra raffles held to offset the HOF banquet costs, the yearend statement showed the Association to be at even.

Committee Reports

Finance (**Barnie***, **Jim**, **Kathy**): All has been reviewed and is in order. Monthly bank statements are forwarded to the President on a monthly basis and everything balances out to the penny.

Youth (**Michelle**): USBC has discontinued the junior awards and shirts this year and is making the sanctions more affordable. The **Green Bay Junior Association** and **Apple Valley Lanes** have been paying the increase to keep the program active. New this year was the formation of the **High School Bowling Program** that was very successful. It will be expanding to 6 schools and 7 teams for next year. There have also been inquiries for a **Middle School program** and that will be realized in the next couple of years. Four (4) teams went to State this year and the **City Tournament** was held at **Apple Valley Lanes**. Four (4) bowlers qualified for the **500 and 600 Tournament** to be held this weekend (8/10-11).

Hall of Fame (**Kathy***, **Barnie**, **Michelle**, **Rose**, **Tracy**, **Pat**): We held our 7th Annual Hall of Fame banquet on 10/20/12 with 80 people in attendance. **Scott Voeks** and **Jason Daubner** were inducted into the Hall of Fame for Superior Performance and **Holly Minahan** and **Joey Plaszkiewicz** were honored as our Junior Bowlers of the Year. **Andy Alger, Todd Cater, Adam Kring** and **Jeff Paschke** were recognized for their 1st ever 300 series. **Rick Davis, Geoff Hansen, Todd Jacobs** and **TJ Lautenbach** were awarded one-time 300 awards for their 1st ever perfect games. Certificates were also awarded to our Youth coaches, **Kathy Franklin, Tim Forbes, Bill Hall** and **Tim Jutila**. County Tournament winners and Association High

Game, High Series, High Average and Most Improved Average winners were also honored. Special guests Don Hildebrand and his wife, Krista, from the Men's State Association were in attendance. This year we also ran 50/50 raffles in all our leagues to raise money to defer the banquet costs due to our declining membership. We were able to cover all costs without monetary support from the Association. Our banquet for this year is set for Saturday, October 19, 2013.

Tournament (Jim*, Todd, Brandon, Mike): We had a very successful tournament this year and the prize fund was boosted by selling advertising and also obtaining extra money from 2 beer distributors. The team event was held at Apple Valley Lanes and the minor events at Sister Bay Bowl and participation was good at both houses. We have 2 divisions and entries are open to all Door County sanctioned bowlers. For anyone interested in getting into the Hall of Fame, participation in 8 tournaments is required. All tournament awards will be presented at the Hall of Fame banquet in October.

Nominating (Tracy*, Mike, Rose): The following positions were up for re-election: President Bernie Haen, Director Tracy VanLanen and Director Rose Polcen. Tracy did not seek re-election.

A slate of 3 bowlers was presented: Jamie Kerscher, Jen Pollock and Bob Nelson. Bernie ran again for President. Motion to accept these 3 as new Directors for the next 3 years and Bernie for the next 2 years was made by Jim Regner, seconded by Joy Bordeau, passed.

Delegates Reports

- A. Bernie attended the Annual Meeting in January in Fond du Lac. Entries for the 2013 Men's State Tournament are steady and entries for the Senior State are rapidly increasing. Hall of Fame Banquet and inductions were also held. Four (4) were inducted. There was no voting on bylaw changes.
- B. No one attended the Women's State Annual Meeting in March.

New Business

- A. Awards program: USBC is discontinuing the awards program effective the 2014-15 season. Information regarding award distribution, approximate costs and USBC award options were presented. After much discussion, it was decided that we, as an Association, would develop our own awards program. Michelle presented a catalog filled with printable items that would be far more useful than magnets or bag tags. League secretaries are encouraged to look through the catalog and choose 3 items. Bernie and Kathy will work on a survey with award choices, award requirements and cost to be handed out to bowlers. A program will then be developed from this feedback as well as the amount of increase to the current membership fee.
- B. Suggestions/Feedback from Delegates: None

Motion to adjourn by Joy Bordeau, seconded by Abby Bordeau, passed. Meeting adjourned at 8:20 p.m.

State tournament under way in Fond du Lac

This past weekend marked the opening of the 111th annual Wisconsin State Bowling Tournament in Fond du Lac. The singles and doubles events are being held at Ledgeview Lanes, a 36-lane house on the east side of town, with the team event at Karl Ray Lanes just off of U.S. 41 across the street from the Mercury Marine complex.

Twenty-nine state directors, resplendent in their gray jackets, lined the approaches at Ledgeview as the colors were presented by a local American Legion Post and "The Star-Spangled Banner" and Pledge of Allegiance were delivered by Stephanie Venz. Following a quick welcoming statement by the mayor, the head of the local Visitors and Convention Bureau presented a check for \$5,000 to be added to the prize fund. We also had "How-de-dos" from the proprietors of both bowling centers.

Then, it was time to choose Joe Bowler for 2013. As usual, the first

shift was primarily from the Osceola area, who specify the opening day every year. In fact, looking up and down the lanes, I only saw one woman among all the guys — a rarity, as many women now participate in the Wisconsin State USBC tournament.

The lucky bowler was the leadoff man on Lane 16, whose name actually was Joe — Joseph Kahl from St. Croix Falls. As per custom, Joe donned a flowing cape and crown (in addition to the scarf he was wearing at the time) and threw the ceremonial first ball of the tournament: a six count, leaving the 1-2-4-8. State Association Manager Don Hildebrand awarded 10 gold dollar coins for the effort while Joe was serenaded with the Osceola Drinking Song, which has now become a semi-official element of the

Joe Bowler ceremony.

After a lunch featuring deli-style salads and sandwiches and checking in at my hotel, it was off to the annual delegates meeting. For those of you who like to plan ahead, the 2014 regular tournament will be held in Milwaukee, with the senior tournament moving from Menomonee to Stevens Point. And, if you really like to plan ahead, it looks like the 2016 and 2017 regular tournaments will be flip-flopped between Green Bay and Madison due to a conflict with the already scheduled state youth tourney.

The Wisconsin State Tournament is the largest in the United States, and has been for many years. The regular tournament has already surpassed 2,000 team entries, although it is down a few hundred from its peak of 2,494 in 2006. The senior event, this year in La Crosse and open to all USBC sanctioned bowlers age 55 and older, continues to grow by leaps and bounds in its 32nd year

(more than 500 teams have registered).

State manager Hildebrand invited us to visit the bowl.com website for more information on the "Welcome to Bowling" clinics available to bowlers sanctioning for the first time and how to set one up. There was also information on the Registered Volunteer Program for certified youth coaches and the announcement that the WINLabs bowling secretary software will soon switch over to WEBLabs — a more web-oriented version.

Four men inducted into state Hall of Fame

The Wisconsin USBC Bowling Association this year inducted four new members into its Hall of Fame — three in the skilled division and one for exemplary service.

The event was held during the opening weekend of the Wisconsin State Bowling Tournament in Fond du Lac — and, unfortunately, occurred at the same time as the Green Bay Packers-San Francisco 49ers playoff game. Many of us were able to follow the first half at our tables thanks to the wonders of wireless Internet technology, and updates were announced by the master of ceremonies between speeches. Still the inductees must have wondered at times why the audience looked so pleased during poignant memories of long-dead mentors or crestfallen at humorous stories regarding past bowling exploits.

The names of those honored will undoubtedly sound unfamiliar to the nonbowlers among my readership. In fact, I



myself knew only one of the three skilled performers — Marc McDowell of Monona — because I remembered seeing him compete on the PBA Tour a few times. Tom Schultz, the exemplary service inductee from Watertown, I know from his work as emcee at previous Hall of Fame banquets.

Lennie Boresch Jr. of Kenosha was elected to the USBC National Hall of Fame last year. He's won three events and ranks in fourth place on the lifetime average list at the USBC tournament at 214.78. I think I've been to the big show four times and hit 200 once or twice out of 36 games. Boresch has 68 perfect games and 17 800 series on his resumé, as well as five Wisconsin State Tournament championships.

Jeff Richgels of Madison was Wisconsin Bowler of the Year in 1985 and Midwest PBA Player of the Year in 1994 and 1999. He won the scratch doubles and all-events state titles in 1991 and his teams have won five state titles in the past nine years. Richgels was inducted into the USBC National Hall of Fame in 2011.

McDowell was a touring PBA member from 1986 to 1995 and won five national titles. He was Rookie of the Year in 1986 and elected PBA President in 1991-92, the youngest ever in that position at age 28. McDowell has 42 perfect games and 21 800 series, and currently serves as commentator for the Wisconsin State High School Bowling Championships.

Schultz has been involved with the local Watertown bowling association since 1965 and first organized its bowling yearbook in the 1967-68 season. He's been on the state board of directors since 1974 and is a

past president. Schultz has bowled in the state tournament for 47 years and organizes squads for both the regular and senior events. He's also been to nationals 30 times.

A couple of observations regarding the State Hall of Fame:

I don't know for sure, but I'm thinking I haven't seen anyone inducted in the skilled division outside of the Madison-Milwaukee-Racine-Kenosha area in my seven years as Door County delegate. Not to say the bowlers have not been deserving — those cities probably comprise half of Wisconsin's population. It just feels like the Hall of Fame is a bit insular.

A good way to get into the Hall is to surround yourself with other great bowlers. Most of the skilled guys inducted over the past five years were all on the same team at one time or another for the state and national tournaments. Boresch likely has the most individual achievements of anyone over that span, if you don't count the guys who were on the pro tour for a significant amount of time.

I may send in a resumé prior to next year's meeting to be considered as a "State Ambassador." Wisconsin is split up into districts, and each district has a director. However, others are encouraged to help out with running the state association. I'm a bit out of the way up here in Door County, but a lot of the business is carried out during conference calls.

Who knows? Maybe I'll be one of the guys with a gray blazer at next year's opening ceremonies.

Daubner, Voeks headed for county hall of fame

Both of our inductees for 2012 are in the Meritorious Category, for bowlers who have performed at a high, sustained level in Door County bowling leagues and tournaments.

Jason Daubner holds the house record at the Sister Bay Bowl of 773, a series on Nov. 11, 2010, that also included the first perfect game thrown there in many years. Daubner had been close to perfection before, throwing a 299 game in February of 2005 during the doubles event of the Door County USBC Tournament.

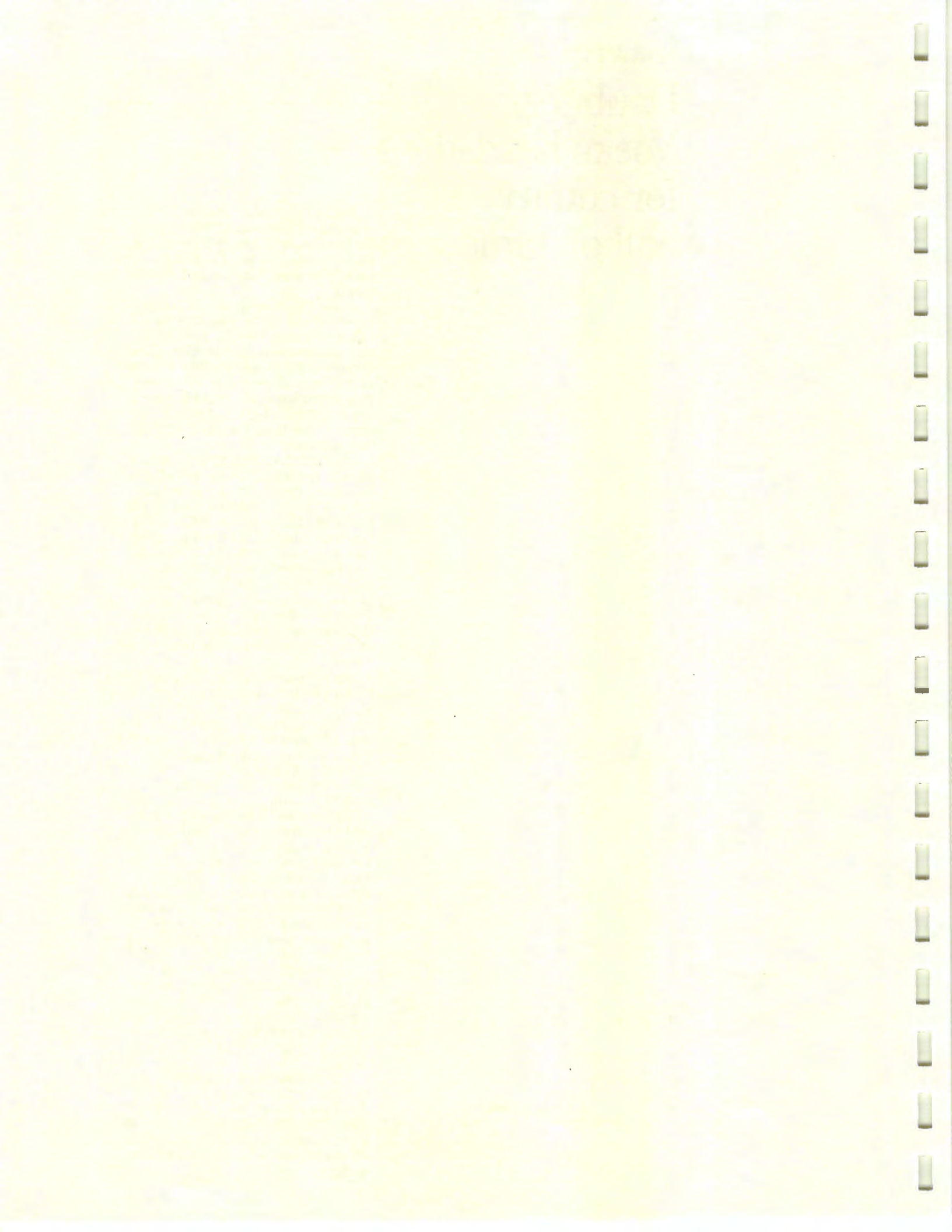
Daubner has consistently been at or near the top of the average list for several years at The Bowl, posting a 217 in the 2010-11 season, a 212 for 2009-10 and 207 for 2007-08. He was a member of the championship five-man team in the 2007 association tournament, rolling the high series in the event of 711. He placed second in the Door County Cup in 2008, as well as second in all-events the same year, and has a long list of other high finishes in the local tournament.

Scott Voeks has been a top performer on Door County bowling alleys since he came out of the Apple Valley Junior Program more than 15 years ago. He has averaged over 200 every season since then, and 223 or better for the past six years, including a 231 during the 2010-11 season.

Understandably, big scores generate big averages. No doubt the biggest of the big scores is the Door County USBC record 825 series that Voeks rolled on Dec. 17, 2010. The records on my laptop may be a little sketchy, but it looks like Voeks has now recorded a total of five 800+ series and nine perfect games (with four near-misses of 299).

Regarding the Door County USBC Tournament, Voeks was the all-events champ in 2009, as well as Door County Cup Scratch Champion and team event winner in 2008 — along with many other top performances.

I hope you've all procured your tickets for Saturday's event. We'll also honor Junior Bowlers of the Year Holly Minahan and Joey Plaszkiwicz, plus the champions from this past season's association tournament.

Payout still pretty good for county tournament

The minor events of the seventh annual Door County USBC Association Tournament at the Sister Bay Bowl are now history. Before I delve into the winners and the big scores, I'd like to take a moment to address what I consider a misconception about our tournament.

Despite our small size, we continue to offer our locally sanctioned bowlers a traditional yearly tournament with team, doubles, singles and all events competitions performed on site. Many larger associations, including Green Bay, do not — having switched their team event to a Mail-o-Graphic qualifier with a one-day Baker Format finals, and eliminated the minor events altogether.

When attempting to register entries for our local tourney, I've run

make the return much better locally than statewide.

Here are the numbers: the 2012 State Tournament divvied up \$411,622 in prize money between 47,440 entrants (five entrants per team, two per doubles, etc.). That comes out to \$8.68 payout per bowler.

The State Senior Tournament last year had \$72,572 in prize money for 9,209 entrants, or \$7.88 payout per bowler. Meanwhile, the Door County USBC Association Tournament paid out \$3,115 between 205 total entrants — an average of \$15.19 per bowler.

That's 1.75 times more per bowler than the regular State Tournament and 1.93 times more than the Senior State Tournament.

And those big state payouts don't stretch far down the final standings.

For instance, only 131 doubles teams out of 5,300 in the handicapped divisions doubled their entry fees — that's one out of 40. In our tournament last year, at least four out of 33 teams more than doubled their return (one in 8.25).

So, no, you won't get rich in the local tournament. But you've got a lot better chance of getting more than your entry fees back than when you go to state.

The focus now shifts to Apple Valley Lanes for the team event Feb. 10 and 24. Although the 2 p.m. shifts on both days are full, a second shift this Sunday at 5 p.m. has been added, so it's still possible to get in on the action. Call Door County USBC Association Manager Kathy Franke at 868-1609.

Now for the results from Sister Bay.

John Voight and Steve Higginbotham were Division 1 doubles champs. Voight has been particularly hot up there in the Tavern League lately, and it must have carried over to the tournament. They totaled 1,465, with Jason Daubner/Mike Snell at 1,445, Bill Hall/Mike Schumacher 1,431 and Curt Meyer/Andy Alger 1,430.

In Division 2, Loren Uecker and Rich Benzshawel pulled victory out of the mouths of Sam Heimbecher and myself on the final day of competition by totaling 1,425. Sam and I had 1,383, followed by Rose Polcen and Jamie Kerscher with 1,366.

Mike Snell took the Division 1 singles crown, scoring a 763 with handicap. Leif Mickelson was second at 756, with Kathy Franke at 720 and Jason Daubner at 714.

In Division 2, Heather Laughlin finished with a total of 749 with Uecker the runner-up at 722 and Augie Malkmus in third at 714.

Snell is undoubtedly the star of the tournament thus far, rolling 700 series in both the doubles (748-279, 268) and singles (707-253). Mickelson's singles score was based on a 705 scratch series including a 279 game.

Andy Alger put up a 718 series in the doubles event, also rolling a 279, and Mike Daubner shot 707 in doubles. Curt Meyer (264, +86 over 178 average) and Al Schmidt (269, +80 over 189 average) had excellent individual games in the doubles event.

across some teams and individuals who feel that their participation is not worth the time and effort because of low payouts. In some ways, this is a valid argument. Door County can't match the \$1,000-per-bowler award for winning an event, as does the Wisconsin State Tournament (still the largest such tourney in the nation, by the way).

However, the Door County USBC Bowling Tournament has something else going for it: sponsorships, 50-50 raffles and the traditional portion of local dues going into the tournament prize fund actually

Team record fell in county tournament

The team event of the Door County USBC Tournament was held over two non-consecutive weekends last month at Apple Valley Lanes, sewing up the 2013 competition which had begun with the singles and doubles events at the Sister Bay Bowl in January.

I've already let the cat out of the bag regarding Mike Snell's perfect game on the first weekend. What I haven't yet reported is that the Alexander's team of Snell, Brett Anschutz and Jason Daubner also broke a long-standing association record for three-person game score on their way to the Division 1 team

title.

A second game consisting of Snell's perfect, 259 by Anschutz and 226 by Daubner added up to 785 — eclipsing by four pins the previous record of 781 set way back in 1998 by Tim Forbes, Scott Voeks and Kevin Beaudoin in the Apple Valley Classic. Anschutz totaled 698 for the day, with Snell at 697 and Daubner at 669. I cannot verify that their 2,064 scratch series was

also a record, as I don't have hard evidence of the Forbes-Voeks-Beaudoin total, which I remember being in the same vicinity, numbers-wise. Along with 147 pins of handicap, Alexander's 2,211 easily outpaced Hannemann-Gosser II (2,087) and JAS (2,081) for the top spot.

The Division 2 champs, however, would have given them a run for their money. Neighborhood Pub I, consisting of Jim Dupras (609), Bill Jarman (603) and Tim Jutila (649), finished with 2,202 including 341 handicap pins. Second place went to Van's Bar with 2,068, followed by WDOR (1,983).

Mike Cuculi rolled the

high series of the tournament, shooting 771 (278). Besides Snell's 300 game, he also tallied a 279 — as did Al Schmidt, Andy Alger and Leif Mickelson. Kathy Franke had the only 600 series among the women — a 631 — and a high game of 226. Tracy VanLanen and Heather Laughlin each bowled games of 222.

Snell ran away with the Division 1 all-events title, shooting 748 in doubles, 707 in singles and the aforementioned 697 in team for 2,152 scratch and 2,320 with handicap. Runner-up honors went to Schmidt with 2,186 and third to Jutila at 2,168.

In Division 2, the all-events winner was Loren Uecker, who totaled 2,094 with handicap. Uecker was also Division 2 doubles champ with teammate Rich Benzshawel. He edged Division 2 singles champ Heather Laughlin and John Voigt who, along with doubles partner Steve Higginbotham, prevented a Snell sweep in the tournament. Teamed with Jason Daubner, Snell fell 20 pins short in doubles, leaving him with three championships (singles, team, all-events) and one runner-up finish.

Many thanks to everyone who participated in our local tournament, and a huge thank you to Tournament Director Jim Regner, who lined up sponsors, coordinated things at Apple Valley and the Bowl, scheduled scorekeepers and rounded up bowlers. Checks will be out shortly and winners swag will be awarded at our yearly Hall of Fame/Awards Banquet in the fall.

New one-day tourney attracts bowlers of all averages

For many years, Apple Valley Lanes ran a one day tournament, usually in the spring, which drew some of the top bowlers from around Northeastern Wisconsin to Sturgeon Bay.

But over time, participation waned as the number of similar events statewide dwindled. Few local bowlers competed, feeling that they had little chance against high rollers from Green Bay, Manitowoc and other larger cities. Eventually, AVL pulled the plug to concentrate on its Nine Pin No Tap tournament.

This year, however, AVL came back with a new one-day event, specifically for its own league bowlers. Held March 30, the Apple Valley Lanes In House

Singles Tournament debuted with a near-capacity 34 entrants. It would have been 35, but I was out of town for the weekend.

The best thing about the tournament was that it attracted bowlers of all averages. The handicap was set at 90 percent of 230, lessening the advantage usually held by the kegeling elite.

All bowlers rolled three qualifying games, skipping a pair of lanes between each game (for instance, bowling on 1-2, 5-6 and 9-10). The field

was then cut in half to the top 17 scores with handicap. Another game was thrown, and the field was again cut in half to the nine best scores in that fourth game. A fifth game was rolled; then, the top three scores competed for the championship in a final sixth game.

After all was said and done, the inaugural championship went to Norm Wipperfurth. Travis Rosinsky finished second and Ray Brock third. Scott Voeks, Rich Benshawel and Bob Nelson rounded out the paying spots (as determined by their performance in the fifth game).

I was encouraged by how well the tournament was received in its first year. Because of the format, in which a total of six games are rolled

by the eventual finalists, entries would have been capped at 36. The champion, Wipperfurth, averages somewhere in the neighborhood of 185. Brock, Benshawel and Nelson also competed with relatively modest averages.

It seems to me that Apple Valley has resurrected its one-day tournament in a form that offers a reward to its league bowlers without the incursion of high-scoring outsiders who tended in the past to carry away the spoils. I'm looking forward to getting a spot for next year — if it doesn't fill up so fast I don't have the chance.

Englebert's 802 sets early pace in county

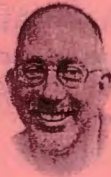
Dale Englebert rolled Door County's first 800 series of the season last week, finishing with an 802 in the Apple Valley Majors.

Women's 700 Series

Pfannenstiel rolls her second 700

Over time, 700 or greater series for women in the local association have more or less equaled the 800s or better for men. In fact, 26 such series have been rolled in Door County bowling history by each sex, respectively.

However, although 20 of the 26 men's 800 series have been recorded in the past four years, women have only topped the 700 mark three times in the same time period.

The latest to scale that mountain was Michelle Pfannenstiel, who shot 702 on Feb. 18 in the Apple Valley Classic league on games of 228-244-230. It was Pfannenstiel's second 700 series, barely missing a career high of 703 — also rolled in the Classic on Nov. 17, 2008.

It occurred just over two years following the last women's 700, a 704 in the Women's Masters by Kathy Franke on Feb. 14, 2011. Only five women in Door County USBC history have achieved a 700 series: 11 by Franke, eight by Sue Sperber, four by Stephanie Hartel, two now by Pfannenstiel and one by Lisa Hartel. Franke's 736 during the 1998-99 season remains the highest.

"I struggled last year," said Pfannenstiel, who averaged 179 in the 2011-12 season. "Before my dad left for Florida, I told him to drill out a new ball for me. I didn't care what."

For those of you unfamiliar with the Door

County bowling scene, "Dad" is Apple Valley Pro Shop Proprietor Pat Cuculi. What he came up for a ball was a Hammer Tattoo.

Pfannenstiel had already thrown eight 600 series this season with the new ball before the 702 — including five of the previous six outings — and most of them had been pretty healthy. Her average had soared to 197. But there was still a lot of pressure in the last few frames.

"I knew what I needed. I was pretty nervous," said Pfannenstiel. "I didn't just want the 700, I wanted to beat my other score."

Unfortunately, she didn't make it easy on herself. With a spare up in the ninth frame of the third game, she missed out on a career best when she came in light for a six count on her first ball in the tenth. She converted the spare, however, and struck on the fill ball.

Pfannenstiel also had two opens during the series, missing a 4-pin and the 4-7 — both to the right side. I've noticed several bowlers having the same problem lately at Apple Valley; oil in the middle of the lane has fooled right-handers into thinking that their ball

would hook more on its way over to the left side of the pin deck.

And, other than the new ball, Pfannenstiel said that a small, but important adjustment in her hand position has made a big difference.

"My dad also reminded me not to come on top of ball (in my delivery)," she said. "Staying behind the ball has really helped."

I've found the same thing to be true in my game. Since my return from knee surgery, keeping my hand under the ball during my delivery has significantly increased my striking power. I still have a tendency at times to try and force my hook by turning my wrist, which can lead to "spinners" — dead pocket hits that often leave the 5, 7 or 10 pins ... or even worse, an 8-10 split.

Pfannenstiel has now overcome the obstacles between her and 700 twice. Don't be surprised if she does it again before long.

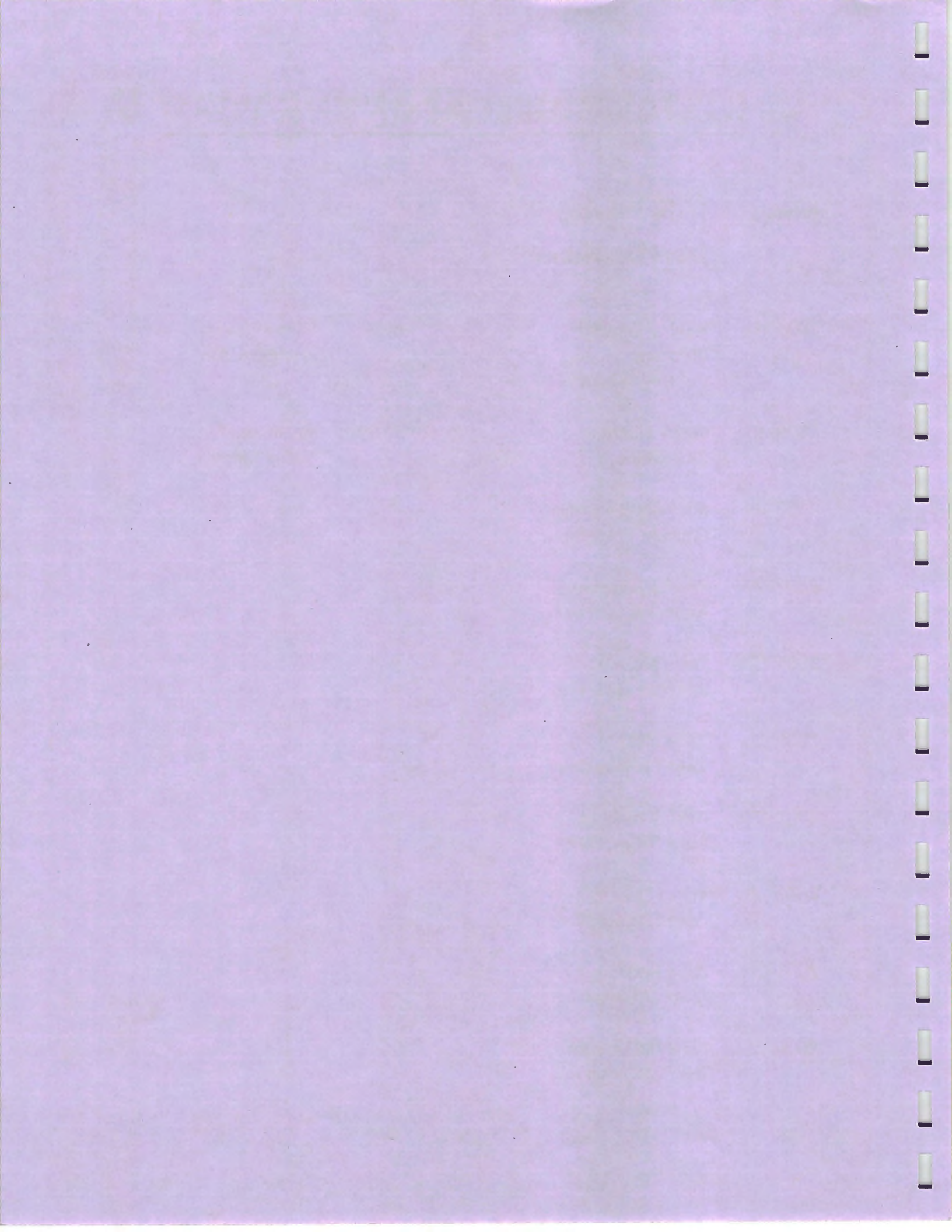

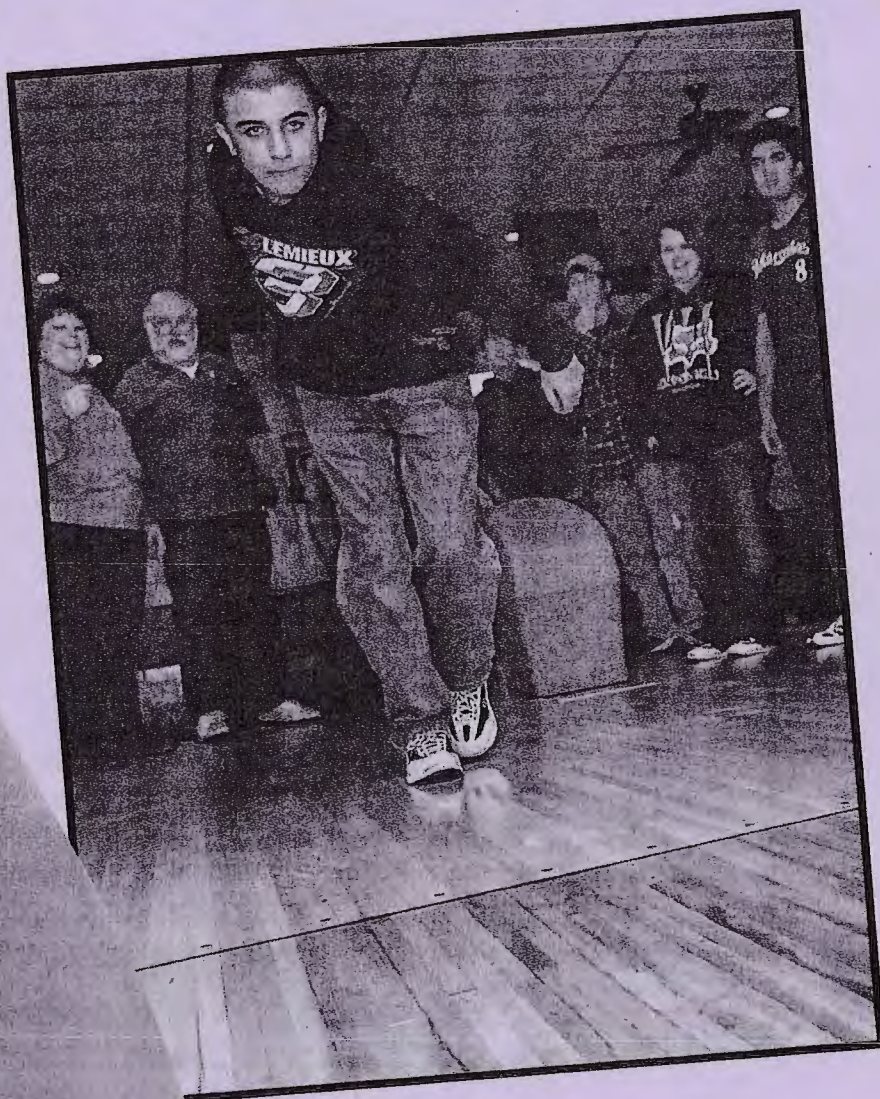

The newly formed Door County High School Bowling Conference is ready to roll.

Two club teams from Sturgeon Bay and one each from Southern Door and Sevastopol schools have been practicing for the past three weeks and will make their official debut at 4 p.m. Thursday at Apple Valley Lanes in Sturgeon Bay.

Apple Valley Lanes owner Pat Cuculi and his daughter Michelle Pfannenstiel worked with the schools and the Bowling Centers Association of Wisconsin to get this first-of-its-kind league for Door County up and running. The league is sanctioned by the BCAW, which oversees the sport for more than 400 high school teams throughout the state.

"My dad wanted to do this for years and he just never got it going," said Pfannenstiel. "But this past June, it all started to come together. It's been a lot of work and a lot of red tape to establish this conference, but hopefully it will all pay off in the end. It will be fun for the kids. I can't wait for Thursday. We're really excited."

The local schools are involved in the league in name only. Pfannenstiel said the league is currently supported through players' fees, with the possibility of future funding coming from grants.

Pfannenstiel said 20 students have joined the coed league so far, including 16 boys and four girls. Each team has the recommended five players to compete head-to-head under the Baker System, a common bowling format where each member of a team alternates frames.

"I'm excited and ready to go," said Sevastopol junior Nick Cater, 16. "I think it's going to be a lot of fun. I'm looking forward to bowling against kids from other schools who like to compete."

Pfannenstiel said she recruited four highly skilled bowlers to coach the teams: Carl Beckstrom at Southern Door, Bob Nelson at Sevastopol, and Bill Hall and Tim Jutila at Sturgeon Bay.

"They have a lot of knowledge and talent to share with the kids," said Pfannenstiel. "They all get paid, but they've been volunteering to give their money

back for equipment and other things. You can see the passion they have for the kids to really learn and enjoy the sport."

The schools will compete in 10 conference meets, while Pfannenstiel is also trying to arrange two nonconference meets

against teams from Green Bay. At the end of the season, the teams will compete in a sectional tournament with the chance to qualify for the state championships March 2 and 3 in Wausau.

Pfannenstiel said there were 439 high school bowling teams in the state last season, including 51 in the Green Bay area. She's hopeful the local interest will spread quickly.

"For the first year, I'd just like to see the kids get their feet wet and enjoy the experience," she said. "Beyond this year, our hopes are to get Gibraltar involved and look to reach out to Algoma and Kewaunee. We're looking to promote the sport long-term and have seven or eight teams next year. That might be a big dream, but I think it's possible."

9. Prep bowling league forms

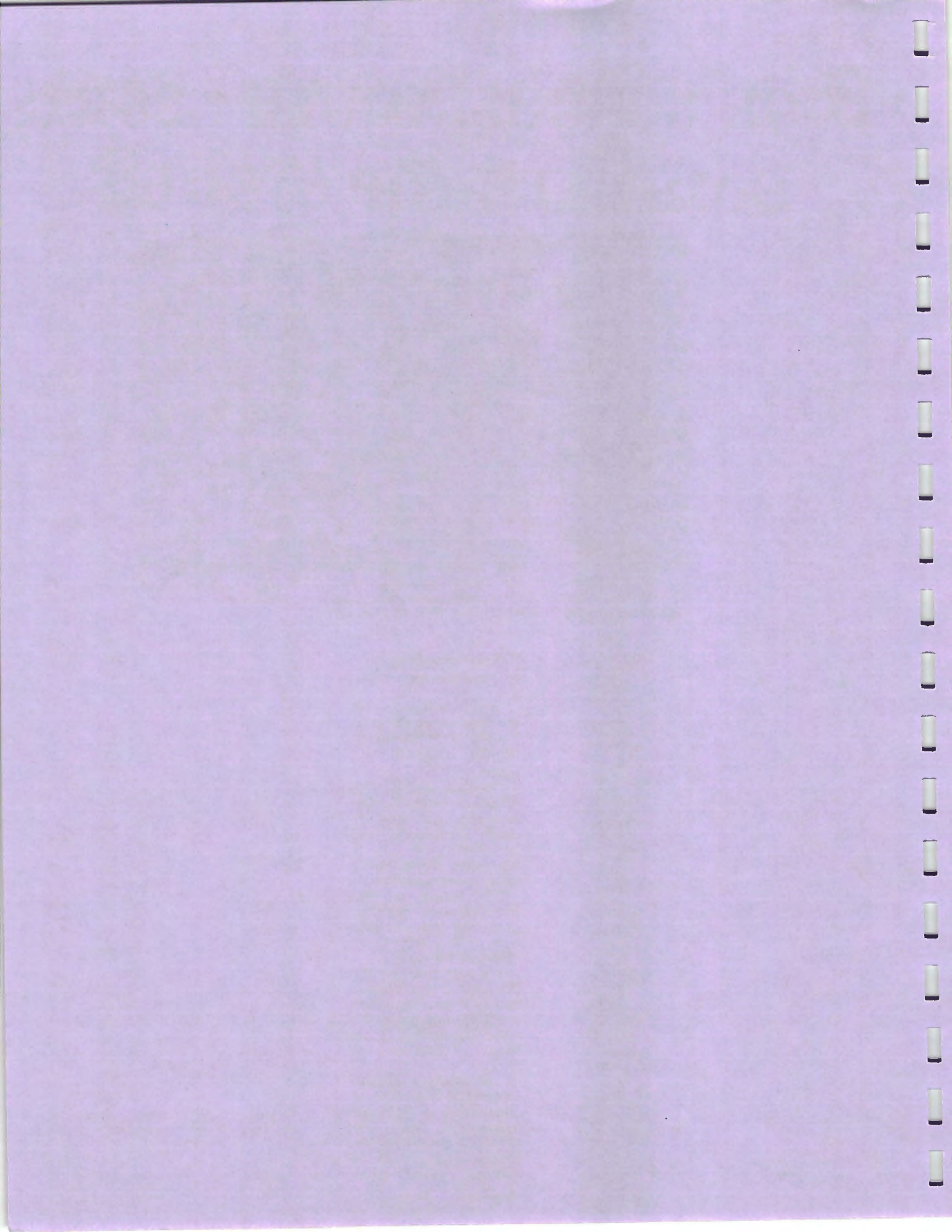
A first-of-its-kind bowling league for Door County high school teams debuted earlier this month.

Area youth bowlers have shown their stuff in the Green Bay Youth Bowling Association Tournament (of which Door County is a part), the Association High Average Tournament, and the State Youth Tournament. It's not been uncommon for our kids to post great scores against the top young bowlers in Northeastern Wisconsin and the rest of the state.

But now, high school club bowling is finally becoming a reality here in Door County.

Beginning with sign-up and practice on Oct. 31 and Nov. 7 at 4 p.m., continuing with practice throughout November and with 11 meets during December, January and

February, local kids will now be able to bowl for their schools. The season will end with the state meet in early March of 2013.

Best of all, qualified coaches will be there at every practice and at every match to polish your bowling skills — not just for your high school years, but for a lifetime.
